WHEREAS, the North Bergen Municipal Utilities Authority (the "Authority") is a public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey, organized and existing under the Municipal and County Utilities Authority Law, constituting Chapter 183 of the Laws of 1957 (the "Act") and an ordinance creating the same finally adopted by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen (the "Township") on October 15, 1981; and

WHEREAS, the Authority is a public instrumentality exercising essential government functions including the ownership, maintenance and operation of a sewerage system (the "System") to serve the needs of the Township and, by agreement, the sewerage generated in the Township and neighboring municipalities, in accordance with the provisions of the Act; and

WHEREAS, the Act permits the Authority to issue negotiable bonds or notes to finance the acquisition, construction, expansion and maintenance of the System and provides for agreements between the Township and the Authority to secure the purchasers of such negotiable bonds and notes of the Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Township and the Authority entered into a service contract, dated as of March 1, 1989 (the "Service Contract"), providing for the collection and treatment of sewerage generated in the Township and neighboring municipalities by the Authority and the establishment of user charges and budgets by the Authority to cover the costs of such activities; and

WHEREAS, under the Service Contract, the Township has pledged to pay Annual Charges (as such term is defined therein) in amounts determined by the Authority as necessary to pay for the costs and operations of the Authority not covered by Sewer User Charges and payments from other municipal and county users; and

WHEREAS, the Service Contract provides that any Annual Charges so levied will be general obligations of the Township payable ultimately from the levy of ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable property within the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has determined to issue sewer revenue bonds in the principal amount not exceeding \$22,000,000 and any notes issued in anticipation thereof (collectively, the "2017 Bonds"), in one or more series to provide for the work and improvements set forth on Exhibit A, attached hereto, and the payment of the costs of issuance associated with the issuance of the 2017 Bonds (collectively, the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, as the Authority was created by the Township it is anticipated that the authorized officials of the Township will be required to execute certain documents in connection with the issuance of the 2017 Bonds and the Project relating to the creation of the Authority and the obligations of the Township under the Service Contract.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Township hereby grants its consent and approval for (i) the issuance of the 2017 Bonds, (ii) the construction and/or acquisition of the Project and all work necessary to complete the Project, (iii) the distribution and approval of bid documents and specifications as necessary by the Authority for the completion of the Project, and (iv) the execution of any contracts or agreements by the Authority for the completion of the Project.

NORTH BERGEN.**

WHEREAS, the Township is the owner of certain real property identified as Block 303, Lot 40.022, also known as 7516 Broadway situated in the Township of North Bergen, County of Hudson, State of New Jersey consisting of approximately 2,175 squarefeet; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen has determined that the property is not needed for any public use and should be sold for the public benefit; and

WHEREAS, the Local Lands and Buildings Law N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13 provides for a public sale at auction subject to allowable conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen recognize that handicapped drivers face unique difficulties in the location of parking spaces; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen have been empowered by N.J.S.A. 39:4-205 to restrict certain areas for handicapped parking; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 503-93, Ordinance No. 1115-07, Ordinance No. 40-10 and Ordinance No. 203-13 establish the terms and conditions for handicapped spaces.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen that:

Section 1: One restricted handicapped parking space be and hereby is established in front of the residence of **Nayari Burgos – Nieves** of **6917 Liberty Avenue**, **Michael Manuel Jimenez** of **1507 – 47th Street, Apt. # 2** and **Kathleen H. Vargas** of **1115 – 8th Street**, North Bergen, N.J. 07047.

Section 2: The aforesaid space shall be used only by a motor vehicle displaying a permit issued by the North Bergen Police Department identifying the location of said handicapped parking space and the specific motor vehicle entitled to use same.

Section 3: The North Bergen Department of Public Works shall establish a restricted parking zone at the above location and shall erect a sign with the legend “Handicapped Parking for Resident Vehicle License Plate Number “**H 5 2 C Z L**” for **Nayari Burgos – Nieves**, “**4 2 9 8 H D**” for **Michael Manuel Jimenez** and “**4 2 7 2 H D**” for **Kathleen H. Vargas**, and this Ordinance Number.

Section 4: This ordinance shall remain in effect for two (2) years ending December 31st of the second year from its effective date at which point it will expire and be of no further force or effect unless it is renewed for a further two (2) year period by formal resolution of the Board of Commissioners in accordance with Ordinance Nos. 1115-07 and 40-10.

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND RATIFYING THE

DEPARTMENTS IN THE TOWNSHIP NORTH BERGEN**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE

TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN as follows:

Section 1. Background

A. The commission form of government law, N.J.S.A. 40:70-1, et seq., and specifically N.J.S.A. 40:72-9, authorizes the board of commissioners, in their discretion, to provide by ordinance for the appointment of a deputy by each of the directors of the departments as may be deemed necessary for the proper and efficient conduct of the affairs of such departments.

B. The Township of North Bergen ("Township") is a commission form of government, and all the Township Commissioners have historically appointed Deputy Directors, which have been referred to by varying titles such as "Deputy Director," "Confidential Aide to the Mayor," "Confidential Aide to the Director," and "Confidential Aide".

C. Prior Township ordinances reflect that the salary ranges for these positions were routinely set by ordinance of the Board of Commissioners, but the available Township records reveal that the positions of Deputy Director were created only in the Department of Public Safety, the Department of Public Works, and the Department of Revenue and Finance. Record of the creation of the position of Deputy Director in the Department of Public Affairs and the Department of Parks and Public Property could not be located.

D. The Civil Service Commission presently has determined that the statutory Deputy Director position under N.J.S.A. 40:72-9 should be titled for Civil Service purposes as Deputy Municipal Department Head.

E. The Township Board of Commissions wishes to address these various inconsistencies in the historical Township ordinances, and clarify the title of the Deputy Director position from this time forward.

Section 2. Deputy Director Position

The appointment of a Deputy Director by each Director of the Township's Departments is hereby ratified, authorized and approved. For Civil Service purposes, the Deputy Director positions shall be known as Deputy Municipal Department Head, or such other title designation as the Civil Service Commission may determine to be appropriate in the future. Consistent with N.J.S.A. 40:72-9, the position shall be non-competitive and unclassified for Civil Service purposes.

Section 3. Deputy Director Hours & Duties

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:72-9, each Director shall prescribe, in writing, work hours and the powers and duties of the Deputy Director appointed by that Director.

Section 4. Severability

If any article, section, sub-section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason deemed to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 5. Repealer

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistency thereof. Prior Ordinances setting salaries for the titles by which Deputy Directors had been known in the Township are saved from repeal and continue to apply to the Deputy Director position.

Section 6. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.

**AN ORDINANCE RE-ESTABLISHING A FEE SCHEDULE
FOR THE POLICE SHOOTING RANGE AND SUPERSEDING
ORDINANCE NOS. 161-13 AND 284-16**

WHEREAS, the Township of North Bergen ("Township") has constructed a shooting range for use by the North Bergen Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Township wishes to update the fee schedule for making said range available for use by outside law enforcement agencies and professional law enforcement training organizations, which are certified in firearms training and methods of firearms instruction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN that:

Section 1: Fees for the use of the Township's shooting range shall be as follows:

A. Weekends and Holidays

1. A flat fee of \$300.00 per day, plus \$100.00 per hour.

B. Regular Range Business Days

1. A flat fee of \$300.00 per day.
2. Where the range use in any one day exceeds 4 hours, there shall be an additional hourly fee for the time in excess of 4 hours, as follows:
 - a. During normal range business hours, the hourly rate shall be \$60.00.
 - b. During non-normal business hours, the hourly rate shall be \$100.00.

C. The North Bergen Police Department shall determine the normal range business hours, which will consist of 8-hour days, Monday through Friday, except holidays.

D. All hourly charges will be rounded up in 15 minute increments.

Section 2: The Chief of Police shall have discretion in granting and scheduling use of the range by outside law enforcement agencies and professional law enforcement training organizations that are certified in firearms training and methods of firearms instruction, but nothing herein shall be deemed to require any grant of use by the Chief of Police.

Section 3: The Chief of Police shall have discretion in waiving fees in exchange for professional training services rendered to the North Bergen Police Department when hosting firearms training. Said exchange of service shall be in writing and in compliance with the Local Public Contracts Law.

Section 4: Any agency or organization granted permission to use the range must, prior to use, provide the Township with a properly executed Use and Hold Harmless Agreement in a form satisfactory to the Township Attorney and proof of Liability Insurance Coverage in a minimum amount of One Million/Three Million Dollars.

Section 5: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistency thereof. Ordinance Nos. 161-13 and 284-16 are hereby repealed.


