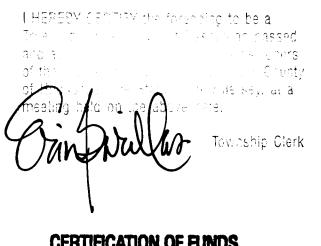

WHEREAS, the North Bergen Municipal Utilities Authority (the "Authority") is a public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey, organized and existing under the Municipal and County Utilities Authority Law, constituting Chapter 183 of the Laws of 1957 (the "Act") and an ordinance creating the same finally adopted by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen (the "Township") on October 15, 1981; and

WHEREAS, the Authority is a public instrumentality exercising essential government functions including the ownership, maintenance and operation of a sewerage system (the "System") to serve the needs of the Township and, by agreement, the sewerage generated in the Township and neighboring municipalities, in accordance with the provisions of the Act; and

WHEREAS, the Act permits the Authority to issue negotiable bonds or notes to finance the acquisition, construction, expansion and maintenance of the System and provides for agreements between the Township and the Authority to secure the purchasers of such negotiable bonds and notes of the Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Township and the Authority entered into a service contract, dated as of March 1, 1989 (the "Service Contract"), providing for the collection and treatment of sewerage generated in the Township and neighboring municipalities by the Authority and the establishment of user charges and budgets by the Authority to cover the costs of such activities; and

WHEREAS, under the Service Contract, the Township has pledged to pay Annual Charges (as such term is defined therein) in amounts determined by the Authority as necessary to pay for the costs and operations of the Authority not covered by sewer user charges and payments from other municipal and county users; and

WHEREAS, the Service Contract provides that any Annual Charges so levied will be general obligations of the Township payable ultimately from the levy of ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable property within the Township; and

WHEREAS, after receiving the approval and consent of the Township pursuant to a resolution adopted by the Township on May 10, 2017, the Authority authorized the issuance of \$22,000,000 in bonds and notes for the project described on Exhibit A hereto (the "Project"), but now due to unforeseen circumstances, including the COVID-19 pandemic, and changes necessary in the scope of the work, the cost of the Project is anticipated to be in an aggregate amount of not to exceed \$28,000,000; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary for the Authority to authorize the issuance of revenue bonds in an additional principal amount not exceeding \$6,000,000 and any notes issued in anticipation thereof (collectively, the "Completion Bonds"), in one or more series to provide for the completion of the work and improvements set forth on Exhibit A, attached hereto, and the payment of the costs of issuance associated with the issuance of the Completion Bonds; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Service Contract the Authority is required to get the approval and consent of the Township to issue bonds and notes, including the Completion Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$6,000,000; and

WHEREAS, as the Authority was created by the Township it is anticipated that the authorized officials of the Township will be required to execute certain documents in connection with the issuance of the Completion Bonds and the Project relating to the creation of the Authority and the obligations of the Township under the Service Contract;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Township hereby grants its approval and consent for (i) the issuance of the Completion Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$6,000,000, resulting in the Township's approval and consent for an aggregate amount of \$28,000,000 of bonds to be issued by the Authority to complete the Project, (ii) the construction and/or acquisition of the Project and all work necessary to complete the Project, (iii) the distribution and approval of bid documents and specifications as necessary by the Authority for the completion of the Project, and (iv) the execution of any contracts, certificates, agreements or other documents by the Authority for the completion of the Project.
- 2. The proper officials of the Township are hereby further authorized to execute such documents as may be necessary for the issuance of the Completion Bonds by the Authority and for the completion of the Project.
- 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

RESOLUTION OPPOSING CONSTRUCTION OF THE NJ TRANSIT GAS-FIRED POWER PLANT IN KEARNY, COUNTY OF HUDSON, NEW JERSEY AND SUPPORT FOR RELYING ON RENEWABLE ENERGY TECHNOLOGY TO POWER THE NEW JERSEY TRANSIT MICROGRID

WHEREAS, NJ Transit has proposed to build a gas-fired power plant ("NJ TRANSITGRID Traction Power System") in Kearny, New Jersey, in a region whose five counties, Bergen, Hudson, Passaic, Union, and Essex have 3.5 million residents, making it among the most densely populated in the country; and

WHEREAS, NJ Transit will use \$546 million of taxpayer money to construct this plant; and

WHEREAS, Northern New Jersey already suffers high levels of air pollution from eight fossil-fuel power plants which are among the largest sources of such pollution in New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, NJ Transit's environmental impact statement estimates this power plant would emit at least 577,000 tons of greenhouse gases annually and emissions would be in direct opposition to the goals of New Jersey's laws, executive orders and policies; and

WHEREAS, according to International Journal of Environmental Research and Public Health, gas infrastructure facilities can annually emit hundreds of tons of pollutants including particulate matter, toxic chemicals such as sulfur dioxide, mercury, and known carcinogens such as benzene and formaldehyde, and are known to increase the severity of asthma and other respiratory diseases; and

WHEREAS, the American Lung Association "State of the Air 2020" report gives Bergen and Hudson counties grades of "F" and Passaic and Essex counties grades of "D" for ground-level ozone air pollution and these counties are out of compliance with Federal Environmental Protection Agency limits on ozone, but, unless significantly modified, this proposed plant will be allowed to increase the concentration of ozone precursors (volatile organic compounds and nitrogen oxides) resulting in increased ground-level ozone in this region through the purchase of "ozone credits;" and

WHEREAS, the American Lung Association "State of the Air 2020" report shows Northern New Jersey already has significant populations with pediatric and adult asthma and COPD, which will be exacerbated by additional volumes of air pollution, and studies have shown ground-level ozone causes premature death; and

WHEREAS, the rapidly declining cost of solar energy and storage have already caused the cancellation of projects using gas to generate electricity and solar energy is forecasted to become significantly cheaper than gas in the coming years, and other renewable energy sources and improvement in energy storage technology will likely leave NJ Transit with a stranded asset thus wasting \$546 million in taxpayer funds; and

WHEREAS, hybrid microgrids using a combination of primarily renewable energy and storage technologies with backup emergency fossil fuel or tidal power (to be used only when the commercial grid is down) have been demonstrated to be cost-effective approaches when compared to all fossil fuel designs for microgrids whose purpose is to provide power when commercial power is not available; and

WHEREAS, hybrid microgrids have potentially better resiliency (through multiple, synergistic sources of power) that may better serve the needs of NJ Transit, while eliminating virtually all air pollution emissions; and

WHEREAS, NJ Transit has been relying, in large part, on a six-year-old 2014 feasibility analysis to support the proposed NJ TRANSITGRID gas-fired power plant, notwithstanding the fact that natural gas is becoming an increasingly less attractive energy source because of the rapidly improving cost-effectiveness of renewable technologies; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen does not oppose NJ Transit's efforts to improve the resiliency of public transportation and recognizes that the many jobs involved in this project, if not more, will still be created by using a hybrid microgrid solution instead of a gas-fired power plant; and

WHEREAS, trade union workers in our state deserve economic expansion and infrastructure projects that don't negatively impact our public health and environment, and which are forward-looking and will develop needed skills and expertise in renewable energy technologies; and

WHEREAS, due to extensive opposition to the project from environmental advocates and local communities, NJ Transit officials have indicated the agency will seek information from potential vendors in order to incorporate renewable energy sources into the project; and

WHEREAS, while these statements by NJ Transit are a positive development, because there is neither a formal commitment nor a NJ Transit approved plan to definitively utilize renewable energy rather than fossil fuels for the plant, there is a continuing need to voice opposition to the proposed gas-fired NJ Transit power plant; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen has a principal responsibility to protect the health and safety of its residents and businesses as well as to ensure the prudent spending of tax dollars paid by its citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN, in the interest of protecting its residents and businesses, opposes construction of this gas-burning NJ Transit power plant; and

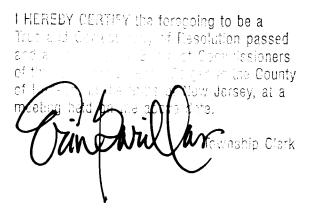

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN'S RENT CONTROL ORDINANCE TO EXTEND THE MORATORIUM ON RENT INCREASES UPON RENT-CONTROLLED PROPERTIES DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN, as follows:

Section 1. <u>Background</u>

A. By Township of North Bergen Ordinance No. 467-93, as amended, the Township regulates, controls and stabilizes rents under its police powers in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Township.

B. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the Township further amended Ordinance 467-93 by enacting Ordinances 463-20 and 469-20, which together imposed a temporary moratorium on rental increases on Rent Controlled Dwellings until the earlier of the following: The end of the Covid-19 State of Emergency declared by the Governor of the State of New Jersey on March 9, 2020 (Executive Order 103) or by November 1, 2020.

C. The Township has determined that the continuing Covid-19 pandemic requires an extension of the temporary moratorium on rental increases.

D. The Township Board of Commissioners also finds that this Ordinance should take effect immediately upon final adoption, and that the 20day waiting period pursuant <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40:74-4 should not apply because this Ordinance's immediate enactment is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of North Bergen's residents.

Section 2: <u>Rent Increase Moratorium Extended</u>

Ordinances 463-20 and 469-20 are amended to replace Section 2, Paragraph D with the following language:

- D. "Moratorium Period" shall begin upon final adoption of Ordinance 463-20, which was May 13, 2020, and continue until the earlier of the following:
- 1. The end of the Covid-19 State of Emergency declared by the Governor of the State of New Jersey on March 9, 2020 (Executive Order 103); or
- 2. December 31, 2020.

Section 3. <u>Penalties</u>

The penalty and violation provisions set forth in the Rent Control Ordinance 467-93 are applicable for any violations of this Ordinance.

Section 4. <u>Repealer</u>

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistency thereof.

Section 5. Liberal Construction

This Ordinance, being necessary for the welfare of the Township residents, shall be liberally construed to effectuate its purposes.

Section 6. <u>Severability</u>

If any part or parts of this Ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 7. <u>Effective Date</u>

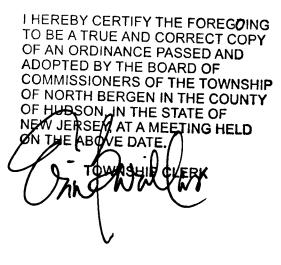
