

Section 1. That all those streets heretofore referred to and shown on the Tax Map of the Township of North Bergen and designated as

Meadow Lane, lying between Bellman's Creek and the N.Y.S. & W.R.R. Railroad Ave. lying between N.Y.C. & H.R.R.R. and the N.Y.S. & W.R.R. Railroad Ave., lying between N.Y.C. & H.R.R.R. and the N.Y.S. & W.R.R. 91st St. (Meyers Ave.) lying between N.R.R. of N.J. and Bellman's Creek and 92nd St. (Grant St.) lying between Railroad Avenue and Railroad Avenue 93rd St. (Chastnut St.) lying between Railroad Avenue and Bellman's Creek

which said streets might have been dedicated to the Township of North Bergen in the County of Hudson and State of New Jersey be, and the same are hereby vacated for use as public streets or highways and all public easements and all public rights in the same excepting only to the maintenance or reconstruction of sewers in 91st Street (Meyers Avenue) are hereby surrendered and extinguished.

Section 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances which are in conflict with this ordinance or any part hereof are hereby repealed as to the conflicting portions thereof.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect when adopted and published as required by law.
