AN ORDINANCE TO SUPPLEMENT AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A DAY AND NIGHT POLICE TO REGULATE THE MANNER OF THEIR APPOINTMENT AND THEIR DUTIES" ADOPTED DECEMBER 20, 1923

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen in the County of Hudson do ordain:

Section 1. That Section 1 of an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance to establish a Day and Night Police to regulate the manner of their appointment and their duties," and all the supplements and amendments thereto be and the same is hereby supplemented by adding thereto a subsection, to be known as subsection "a", reading as follows.

a. That there be created a Detective Bureau composed of detectives referred to herein which bureau shall be under the direction and control of a Chief of Detectives who shall be appointed to such office from among the senior grade detectives.

Section 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance or any part thereof, are hereby repealed as to the conflicting portion thereof, and that this ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication, as required by law.
