**SECTION 1.** That Section 1 of an ordinance entitled as above  
be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That on and after January 1st, 1949, the salaries  
to be paid to the officers and members of the Police Depart-  
ment of the Township of North Bergen in the County of Hudson,  
N. J. shall be as follows:

For the Office as Chief, the sum of \$5,500.00 per annum.  
For the Office of Captain, the sum of \$4,500.00 per annum.  
For the Office of Lieutenant, the sum of \$4,000.00 per annum.  
For the Office of Sergeant, the sum of \$3,500.00 per annum.  
For the Office of Detective Senior Grade, the sum of  
\$3,450.00 per annum.  
For the Office of Detective Junior Grade, the sum of  
\$3,250.00 per annum.  
For the Office of Surgeon, the sum of \$3,700.00 per annum.  
For the Office of Assistant Surgeon, the sum of \$3,000.00  
per annum.  
For the Office of Radio Operator, the sum of \$3,250.00  
per annum.  
For the Office of Police Matron Nurse, the sum of \$3,000.00  
per annum.  
For the Office of Patrolman,:

For the first six months of service, the sum of  
\$2,500.00 per annum and after six months of such service,  
the sum of \$3,000.00 for each succeeding year.

For the Office of Employee, the sum of \$2,900.00 per annum

**SECTION 2.** That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in  
conflict with this ordinance or any part of it are hereby  
repealed as to the conflicting portions and that this ordinance  
shall take effect when same is published and adopted as  
required by law.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO PAUL SADLON, HIS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, PERMISSION TO MAINTAIN A CERTAIN ENCROACHMENT OF APPROXIMATELY 4 FEET OVER THE WESTERLY LINE OF DURHAM AVENUE, IN THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN IN THE COUNTY OF HUDSON", ADOPTED MARCH 19th, 1947.

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen in the County of Hudson, do ordain:

Section 1: That the 1st paragraph of the recital to an ordinance entitled as above be amended so as to read as follows:

WHEREAS Paul Sadlon, owner of property known as Lot 39 in Block 188 has made application in writing to the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen, for permission to maintain an encroachment to the Building located at 1300 - 51st Street, North Bergen as it now stands on the Westerly line of Durham Avenue;

Section 2: That Section 1 of said ordinance be amended so as to read as follows:

Permission is hereby granted to Paul Sadlon, his successors and assigns to maintain an encroachment over the westerly line of Durham Avenue for a width of 4.06 feet at the front of said building increasing to 4.20 feet at the rear of said building for a total depth of 48 feet, in Lot 39, Block 188 located at 1300 - 51st Street.

2: The Township Engineer be hereby directed to amend the "Use District Map" to conform to the changes hereinabove set forth.

3: This ordinance shall take effect when adopted and published as required by law.

DECEMBER 20, 1923

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of North  
Bergen in the County of Hudson do ordain:

Section 1. That Section 1 of an ordinance entitled  
"An Ordinance to establish a Day and Night Police to regulate  
the manner of their appointment and their duties," and all the  
supplements and amendments thereto be and the same is hereby  
supplemented by adding thereto a subsection, to be known as  
subsection "a", reading as follows:

a. That there be created a Detective Bureau com-  
posed of detectives referred to herein which bureau shall be  
under the direction and control of a Chief of Detectives who  
shall be appointed to such office from among the senior grade  
detectives.

Section 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances  
in conflict with this ordinance or any part thereof, are here-  
by repealed as to the conflicting portion thereof, and that  
this ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication,  
as required by law.

**NORTH BERGEN TRAFFIC ORDINANCE**  
**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SPECIAL TRAFFIC CONDITIONS EXISTING ON THE STREETS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN, NEW JERSEY, AND IMPOSING CERTAIN PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC SAFETY OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HUDSON, NEW JERSEY, TO THE EXTENT OF THE CONFLICT HEREOF.**

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen, County of Hudson, do ordain:

**SECTION 1. DEFINITION OF TERMS:** The words and phrases used in this ordinance shall have the meanings ascribed to them in Chapter 39-1 of the Revised Statutes of New Jersey regulating the operation of motor vehicles. The term "Director" shall be deemed to mean the Director of Public Safety of the Township of North Bergen. The term "Township" shall be deemed to be the Township of North Bergen.

**SECTION 2. TRAFFIC ADMINISTRATION:**

**2-01 POLICE ADMINISTRATION:** There is hereby established in the Police Department of the Township of North Bergen a Traffic Advisory Committee consisting of a member of the Police force designated by the Director, a member of the Township Engineering Department, the Township Magistrate, a member of the School System and not more than five civilian members appointed by the Director. Of the civilian members two members shall be appointed for a term of one year, two members shall be appointed for a term of two years and one member for a term of three years. Annually thereafter, members shall be appointed by the Director for a term of three years. Vacancies shall be filled for unexpired terms. The members of the Traffic Advisory Committee shall have the right to call upon the Director for information without compensation, except as provided for in par. 4-01.

**2-02 DUTIES OF TRAFFIC ADVISORY COMMITTEE:** It shall be the duty of the Traffic Advisory Committee to give such aid as may be required by the Police Department in the enforcement of the traffic regulations of the Township and of all State Vehicle laws applicable to street traffic of the Township, to investigate accidents and to report the same to the officers of the Township in the administration of the traffic laws and in the development of ways and means to improve traffic conditions and to carry out those duties especially imposed upon said Division by this ordinance or other applicable ordinances of the Township.

**SECTION 3. TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS:**

**3-01 THROUGH STREETS, STOP STREETS AND SPECIAL HAZARDS:** The Traffic Engineer shall mark and place appropriate signs and devices in the roadway indicating and helping to protect the same. When authorized signs are erected on a street or portion thereof as a play street, no person shall drive a vehicle upon such street or portion thereof as a play street of vehicles having business or whose residences are within the marked area, and then such driver shall exercise the greatest possible care in driving upon such street or portion thereof. The streets in the following schedule are hereby designated as play streets:

- First Avenue, between 87th Street and 90th Street.
- Columbia Ave., between 52nd Street and 53rd Street.
- 11th Street, between Hudson Boulevard and Pat. Plk. Rd.

**SECTION 4. THROUGH STREETS, STOP STREETS AND SPECIAL HAZARDS:**

**4-01 THROUGH STREETS:** The streets of portion of streets described in the following schedule are hereby declared to be through streets:

- Park Avenue
- Bergenline Avenue
- 27th Street at Grand Avenue
- 48th Street at Hudson Boulevard
- 48th Street at Grand Avenue
- 72nd Street at Palisade Avenue
- 14th Street at Broadway
- 75th Street at Hudson Avenue
- 75th Street at Park Avenue
- 77th Street at Hudson Avenue
- 89th Street at Hudson Boulevard

**SECTION 5. AUTHORITY TO ERECT STOP SIGNS:**

Whenever any ordinance in the Township designates a street as a "Through Street," it shall be the duty of the Traffic Engineer to place and maintain a stop sign on each and every street intersecting such "Through Street" and designated as such by any ordinance of the Township.

**SECTION 6. BUS STOPS:**

Buses shall stop at the curb or "pick up" side of each street intersection to pick up and discharge passengers on:

- Bergenline Ave., between Gutt. Line and Hudson Blvd.
- 75th St., between B'line Ave. and Hudson Blvd.
- 75th St., between B'line Ave. and Park Ave.
- Park Ave., between Gutt. Line and 75th St.

**SECTION 7. SPECIAL REGULATIONS FOR CONGESTED STREETS:**

All traffic on Bergenline Ave., between Guttenberg Line and 90th Street shall stop at the nearest corner when traffic lights change from green to red.

**SECTION 8. AUTHORITY TO PLACE AND OBEYANCE TO TURNING MARKERS:**

**(a)** Whenever authorized markers, buttons or other indications are placed within an intersection indicating the course to be traveled by vehicles turning right or left, no driver of a vehicle shall disobey the directions so indicated.

**(b)** The Traffic Engineer is authorized to place markers, buttons or signs within or adjacent to intersections indicating the course to be traveled by vehicles turning at such intersections.

**SECTION 9. PUBLIC EMPLOYEES TO OBEY TRAFFIC REGULATIONS:**

The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to the driver of any vehicle owned or used in the service of the United States Government, this State, County or Township, and it shall be unlawful for any driver to violate any of the provisions of this ordinance, except as otherwise permitted herein or by State law.

**SECTION 10. EXEMPTIONS TO AUTHORIZED EMERGENCY VEHICLES:**

**(a)** The provisions of this ordinance regulating the operation of parking and standing of vehicles shall not apply to authorized emergency vehicles except when otherwise directed by a police officer.

**(b)** The foregoing exemptions shall not protect a driver of a vehicle from the consequences of his reckless disregard of the safety of others.

**TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES:**

**4-01 TRAFFIC ENGINEER:** The Office of Traffic Engineer is hereby established. The Traffic Engineer shall be appointed by the Director under the provisions of the Civil Service Act and shall exercise the powers and duties as provided in this ordinance and the Director may with the consent of the Board of Commissioners designate a Township Engineer to serve as Traffic Engineer in addition to his other functions at such additional compensation as may be proper. The term of office of Traffic Engineer or the Township Engineer while serving an appointment as Traffic Engineer shall be during good behavior.

**4-02 AUTHORITY TO INSTALL CONTROL DEVICES:** The Traffic Engineer shall place and maintain traffic control devices, signs and signals when such are required under this ordinance to make effective the provisions of said ordinance, and may place and maintain additional traffic control devices as he may deem necessary to regulate traffic under this ordinance and to State law, or to warn traffic, subject to the approval of the Director of the State Division of Motor Vehicles.

**4-03 MANUAL AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR CONTROL DEVICES:** All traffic control devices, signs and signals shall conform to the manual of specifications approved by the State Division of Motor Vehicles. All signals required hereunder for a particular purpose shall, as far as practicable, be uniform as to design, type and location throughout the Township. All traffic control devices so erected and not inconsistent with the provisions of State Law or this ordinance shall be official control devices.

**4-04 PLAY STREETS:** The Traffic Engineer shall mark and place appropriate signs and devices in the roadway indicating and helping to protect the same. When authorized signs are erected on a street or portion thereof as a play street, no person shall drive a vehicle upon such street or portion thereof as a play street of vehicles having business or whose residences are within the marked area, and then such driver shall exercise the greatest possible care in driving upon such street or portion thereof. The streets in the following schedule are hereby designated as play streets:

- First Avenue, between 87th Street and 90th Street.
- Columbia Ave., between 52nd Street and 53rd Street.
- 11th Street, between Hudson Boulevard and Pat. Plk. Rd.

**SECTION 6. BUS STOPS:**

Buses shall stop at the curb or "pick up" side of each street intersection to pick up and discharge passengers on:

- Bergenline Ave., between Gutt. Line and Hudson Blvd.
- 75th St., between B'line Ave. and Hudson Blvd.
- 75th St., between B'line Ave. and Park Ave.
- Park Ave., between Gutt. Line and 75th St.

**SECTION 7. SPECIAL REGULATIONS FOR CONGESTED STREETS:**

All traffic on Bergenline Ave., between Guttenberg Line and 90th Street shall stop at the nearest corner when traffic lights change from green to red.

**SECTION 8. AUTHORITY TO PLACE AND OBEYANCE TO TURNING MARKERS:**

**(a)** Whenever authorized markers, buttons or other indications are placed within an intersection indicating the course to be traveled by vehicles turning right or left, no driver of a vehicle shall disobey the directions so indicated.

**(b)** The Traffic Engineer is authorized to place markers, buttons or signs within or adjacent to intersections indicating the course to be traveled by vehicles turning at such intersections.

**(a)** The provisions of this ordinance regulating the operation of parking and standing of vehicles shall not apply to authorized emergency vehicles except when otherwise directed by a police officer.

**(b)** The foregoing exemptions shall not protect a driver of a vehicle from the consequences of his reckless disregard of the safety of others.

**(d)** Application for a bicycle license and license plate shall be made upon a form provided by the Township and shall be made to the Police Department.

**SECTION 6. ONE WAY STREETS**

**6-01 SCHEDULE:** The streets listed in the following schedule are hereby designated as "One Way" streets and traffic shall move on said streets only in the direction indicated.

**SECTION 8. PARKING STANDARDS:**

No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle other than a taxicab in a taxicab stand if any such stop or stand has been officially designated and appropriately signed except that the driver of a passenger vehicle may temporarily stop therein for the purpose of loading or unloading passengers when such stopping does not interfere with any bus or taxicab waiting to enter or about to enter the same. The following locations are hereby designated as taxicab stands:

- Bergenline Avenue (East Side) North of Hudson Blvd.
- Bergenline Avenue at #7018
- Bergenline Avenue at #3121
- Liberty Avenue, West of 43rd Street
- Palisade Avenue, West of 43rd Street
- 8th Street (North Side) West of Hudson Blvd.
- 44th Street at #1708

**SECTION 9. PENALTIES:**

**9-01 FINES:** Unless another penalty is expressly provided by law, every person convicted of a violation of any provision of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$50 or by imprisonment for not more than (15) days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

**9-02 DISPOSITION OF TRAFFIC FINES AND FORFEITURES:** All fines or forfeitures collected upon conviction or upon the fifth day shall be paid into the Treasury of the Township and deposited in a special fund known as the "Street Traffic Improvement Fund," which is hereby created and which shall be used exclusively in the construction, maintenance and repair of public streets, bridges and street structures, or for the installation and maintenance of traffic-control devices.

**9-03 AUTHORITY TO IMPOUND VEHICLE:** (a) Members of the police department are hereby authorized to remove a vehicle from a street or highway to the extent necessary to protect the safety, or to a garage designated or maintained by the police department, or otherwise by the Township, under the circumstances hereinafter enumerated.

(b) When a vehicle upon a highway is so disabled as to constitute an obstruction to traffic and the person or persons in charge of the vehicle are by reason of physical injury incapacitated to such an extent as to be unable to provide for its custody or removal.

(c) When any vehicle is left unattended upon a street and is so parked illegally as to constitute a hazard or obstruction to the normal movement of traffic.

(d) Whenever an officer removes a vehicle from a street or highway as authorized in this section and the officer knows or is able to ascertain from the registration records on file in the office of the Township Engineer the owner thereof, such officer shall immediately give or cause to be given notice in writing to such owner of the fact of removal of the vehicle and the reason therefor and of the place to which such vehicle has been removed. In the event any such vehicle is stored in a public garage, a copy of such notice shall be given to the proprietor of such garage.

**SECTION 10. EFFECTIVENESS OF TITLE:**

**10-01 EFFECTIVENESS OF PORTIONS:** If any part or parts of this ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

**10-02 REPEAL:** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, except that this repeal shall not affect or prevent the prosecution or punishment of any person for a violation of any ordinance hereby repealed prior to the taking effect of this ordinance.

**SECTION 11. SHORT TITLE:**

This ordinance may be known and cited as the North Bergen Traffic Ordinance.
