Whereas, 1 in every 3 women will experience domestic violence during her lifetime; 1 in every 4 women will experience sexual assault in her lifetime; 1 in 6 men have had abusive or unwanted sexual experiences in their lifetime and approximately 15.5 million children are exposed to domestic violence every year;

Whereas, when a family member is abused, it can have long-term damaging effects on the victim that also leaves a mark on family, friends, and the community at large;

Whereas, families are indispensable to a stable society, and there should be a place of support to instill responsibility and values in the next generation;

Whereas, violence against women and children is a prevalent social illness due to the historical imbalance of power in gender and age; however, sexual and domestic violence are widespread and are devastating to society as a whole;

Whereas, the problems of sexual and domestic violence are not confined to any group or groups of people, but crosses all economic, racial, gender, educational, religious, and societal barriers, and are sustained by societal indifference;

Whereas, the crimes of domestic and sexual violence violate an individual's privacy, dignity, security, and humanity due to the systematic use of physical, emotional, sexual, psychological, and economic control and/or abuse;

Whereas, victims and their families should have help to find the compassion, comfort, and healing they need, and abusers should be punished to the full extent of the law;

· Whereas, victims of violence should have access to medical and legal services, counseling, emergency and transitional housing, and other supportive services so that they can safely escape the cycle of abuse;

Whereas, it is important to recognize the compassion and dedication of the individuals who provide services to victims of domestic and sexual violence and work to increase public understanding of this significant problem;

Whereas, local programs, state coalitions, national organizations, and other agencies nationwide are committed to increasing public awareness of domestic and sexual violence and its prevalence, and to eliminating it through prevention and education;

TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN HUDSON COUNTY, NEW JERSEY

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING RETROFITTING OF STORM DRAINS ON PRIVATE PROPERTY TO CONTROL FOR LITTER ENTERING PARTS OF THE SEWER SYSTEM

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN that:

Section 1: Background & Findings

- A. There is a need to prevent the discharge of solids and floatables (such as plastic bottles, cans, food wrappers and other litter) to the Township of North Bergen ("Township") sewer system so as to protect public health, safety and welfare.
- B. Various storm sewer grates exist on private property and discharge into the Township sewer system. There is a need to update these storm grates to current standards.
- C. When the owner of private property is performing work or improvements in the area of a storm grate on their property, that is the most efficient and cost-effective manner in which to upgrade the storm grate(s) to current standards.
- D. This Ordinance will require the retrofitting of existing storm drain inlets which are in direct contact with repaving, repairing, reconstruction, resurfacing or alterations of facilities on private property.

Section 2: Definitions

- A. For the purpose of this Ordinance, the following terms, phrases, words, and their derivations shall have the meanings stated herein unless their use in the text of this Ordinance clearly demonstrates a different meaning. When not inconsistent with the context, words used in the present tense include the future, words used in the plural number include the singular number, and words used in the singular number include the plural number. The word "shall" is always mandatory and not merely directory.
 - "Municipal separate storm sewer system" or "MS4" means a conveyance or system of conveyances (including roads with drainage systems, municipal streets, catch basins, curbs, gutters, ditches, manmade channels, or storm drains) that is owned or operated by the Township or MUA, and is designed and used for collecting and conveying stormwater. MS4s do not include combined sewer systems, which are sewer systems that are designed to carry sanitary sewage at all times and to collect and transport stormwater from streets and other sources.
 - "Person" means any individual, corporation, company, partnership, firm, association, or political subdivision of this State subject to municipal jurisdiction.
 - "Storm drain inlet" means an opening in a storm drain used to collect stormwater runoff and includes, but is not limited to, a grate inlet, curbopening inlet, slotted inlet, and combination inlet.
 - 4. "Waters of the State" means the ocean and its estuaries, all springs, streams and bodies of surface or ground water, whether natural or artificial, within the boundaries of the State of New Jersey or subject to its jurisdiction.

Section 3: Prohibited Conduct

A. No person in control of private property (except a residential lot with one single family house) shall authorize the repaving, repairing (excluding the repair of individual potholes), resurfacing (including top coating or chip sealing with asphalt emulsion or a thin base of hot bitumen), reconstructing or altering any surface that is in direct

contact with an existing storm drain inlet on that property unless the storm drain inlet either:

- Already meets the design standard in Section 4 below to control passage of solid and floatable materials; or
- 2. Is retrofitted or replaced to meet the standard in Section 4 below prior to the completion of the project.

Section 4: Design Standard

- A. Storm drain inlets identified in Section 3 above shall comply with the following standard to control passage of solid and floatable materials through storm drain inlets. For purposes of this Section, "solid and floatable materials" means sediment, debris, trash, and other floating, suspended, or settleable solids. For exemptions to this standard, see Section 4.A.3 below.
 - Design engineers shall use either of the following grates whenever they use a grate in pavement or another ground surface to collect stormwater from that surface into a storm drain or surface water body under that grate:
 - a. The New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) bicycle safe grate, which is described in Chapter 2.4 of the NJDOT Bicycle Compatible Roadways and Bikeways Planning and Design Guidelines (April 1996); or
 - b. A different grate, if each individual clear space in that grate has an area of no more than seven (7.0) square inches, or is no greater than 0.5 inches across the smallest dimension. Examples of grates subject to this standard include grates in grate inlets, the grate portion (non-curb-opening portion) of combination inlets, grates on storm sewer manholes, ditch grates, trench grates, and grates of spacer bars in slotted drains. Examples of ground surfaces include surfaces of roads (including bridges), driveways, parking areas, bikeways, plazas, sidewalks, lawns, fields, open channels, and stormwater basin floors.
 - 2. Whenever design engineers use a curb-opening inlet, the clear space in that curb opening (or each individual clear space, if the curb opening has two or more clear spaces) shall have an area of no more than seven (7.0) square inches, or be no greater than two (2.0) inches across the smallest dimension
 - 3. This standard does not apply:
 - a. Where the municipal engineer agrees that this standard would cause inadequate hydraulic performance that could not practicably be overcome by using additional or larger storm drain inlets that meet these standards;
 - b. Where flows are conveyed through any device (e.g., end of pipe netting facility, manufactured treatment device, or a catch basin hood) that is designed, at a minimum, to prevent delivery of all solid and floatable materials that could not pass through one of the following:
 - A rectangular space four and five-eighths inches long and one and one-half inches wide (this option does not apply for outfall netting facilities); or
 - ii. A bar screen having a bar spacing of 0.5 inches.
 - c. Where flows are conveyed through a trash rack that has parallel bars with one-inch (1") spacing between the bars; or
 - d. Where the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection determines, pursuant to the New Jersey Register of Historic Places Rules at N.J.A.C. 7:4-7.2(c), that action to meet this standard is an undertaking that constitutes an encroachment or will damage or destroy the New Jersey Register listed historic property

Section 5: Enforcement

This Ordinance shall be enforced by the North Bergen Building Department.

Section 6: Violations, Penalties and Fines

Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of \$750 for each storm drain inlet that is not retrofitted to meet the design standard set forth herein.

Section 7: Severability

If any part or parts of this Ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 8: Repealer

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistency thereof.

Section 9: Effective Date:

This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days from the time of its final passage.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE USE OF PROCUREMENT CARDS AND ESTABLISHING POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

WHEREAS, the Township of North Bergen ("Township") has previously adopted ordinances controlling payment of claims, including Ordinance Nos. 1183-65 and 372-18; and

WHEREAS, the Township wishes to amend the above Ordinances to include this Ordinance controlling the use of procurement cards ("P-Cards"); and

WHEREAS, the Township Qualified Purchasing Agent ("QPA") has recommended that P-Cards be utilized where appropriate for purchases for the Township; and

WHEREAS, the use of P-Cards can be a highly beneficial tool for local governments looking to further utilize e-commerce and strengthen their purchasing controls; and

WHEREAS, the use of P-Cards is authorized pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:5-16.5(a); and

WHEREAS, the rules adopted by the Department of Community Affairs, Division of Local Government Services, Local Finance Board governing the use of P-Cards are set forth in N.J.A.C. 5:30-9A.1, et seq., and specifically N.J.A.C. 5:30-9A.7; and

WHEREAS, the Township Administrator and Chief Finance Officer ("CFO") agree with the QPA's recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Commissioners find that a P-Card program would be beneficial to the Township and wish to authorize its use and establish policies and procedures as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the following P-Card program policies and procedures have been identified:

- A. How P-Cards May Be Used
 - P-Cards may be utilized for goods or services items under the following circumstances:
 - a. When payment to vendors is required in advance or at the time of the delivery of certain goods or services; the goods or services cannot be obtained from any other source at a comparable price; and the purchase has been authorized by the QPA or is from a vendor having a contract for such goods or services with the Township; or
 - b. When placement of orders for goods and services is made through an electronic computerized transaction (i.e. order is placed from computer to computer via the internet or similar computer network) as authorized by N.J.S.A. 40A:5-16, and the purchase has been authorized by the QPA or is from a vendor having a contract for such goods or services with the Township.
 - Transactions cannot exceed the amount designated and authorized.
 - P-Cards cannot be used for the purchase of items or services of a
 personal nature for employees, volunteers or officials. Travel, dining
 and room and board expenses are also not permitted.

B. P-Card Program Controls

The Township P-Card program shall have the ability to institute the following controls:

- 1. Set limits and review current activity online and in real-time;
- 2. Establish, change, or delete limits on each card individually;
- Restrict the use of individual cards to certain individuals and categories of items;
- 4. Establish a cumulative limit for a specific period;
- Receive sorted or sortable detailed reports of activity by authorized card user, department or spending category; and
- 6. Interface with accounting software such that:
 - a. vendor activity includes all transactions processed through the P-Card, as well as transactions where direct vendor payments are processed, and
 - internal controls are maintained concerning the integrity of vendor payments, including aggregation of costs for goods and services.

C. Procurement Card Program Oversight

- The QPA shall serve in the capacity of Program Manager and shall be responsible for day-to day oversight and management of supervisory review of P-Card usage. Supervisory review means confirming the propriety and accuracy of P-Card usage by all authorized users.
- 2. The CFO shall be responsible for supervising the Program Manager's oversight of the P-Card program.
- Reconciliation of activity shall be conducted by the CFO or another individual under the CFO's supervision (other than the Program Manager).
- 4. The Program Manager and CFO shall assure that internal controls are maintained concerning the integrity of vendor payments, accumulated costs for goods and services as well as other Local Public Contracts Law requirements,
- The Township Administrator, CFO and Program Manager shall receive training in all aspects of the system.
- 6. The Township Administrator, in consultation with the CFO and Program Manager shall identify positions within the Township that will benefit from the use of a P-Card, and establish limits by amount, period (time) and categories of permissible use.
- 7. Under the supervision of the CFO, the Program Manager will develop and administer a supervisory review process, identify and manage all risks associated with P-Card use, as well as engage in any other oversight or management duties required to ensure their proper utilization.
- 8. The Program Manager will organize training for each individual whose duties may at any time include the use of a procurement card, supervisory review or reconciliation of activity in the P-Card program, as well as the Township's policies and procedures

concerning P-Card usage. At the end of the training, all persons trained shall sign an acknowledgement of training and agreement in the form promulgated by the Department of Community Affairs, Division of Local Government Services, Local Finance Board.

- The Program Manager will notify in writing every employee identified as a person who would be offered a P-Card to obtain their consent for the required training.
- 10. P-Cards must be issued in the name of a specific individual upon completion of the requisite training, and cannot be issued to personnel who are neither covered by a fidelity bond or a blanket honesty policy held by the Township (or become ineligible for said coverage after being issued a P-Card).
- Violations of policies governing P-Card use shall result in appropriate remedial or disciplinary action.
- P-Cards may only be used by the specific individual named on the card.
- The Program Manager shall also ensure that

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- All cards have imprinted on them both the users' names and the Township of North Bergen;
- The merchant code(s) are accurate;

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- c. Program participants are aware of the program and approved vendors with whom the cards may be utilized, dependent upon contracts awarded by the Board of Commissioners or entered or authorized by the QPA.
- d. When applicable and bids are advertised, the bid documents include the payments may be made by procurement eard so the Township receives in their bid prices any discount for timely payments.
- 14. Users shall expeditiously provide all receipts to the Program Manager, who will compare receipts to the computer-generated usage report provided by the card company. Returned material must be reported to the Program Manager quickly to ensure the charge is cancelled or the Township receives the proper credit.
- 15. The program manager shall ensure that sufficient funds are encumbered from the proper accounts to cover any charges the user is authorized to make.
- D. Nothing in this policy shall change regulations or requirements pursuant to the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, gt geg.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN as follows:

- Section 1. The aforesaid recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.
- Section 2. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A.5-16.5 and N.J.A.C. 5:30-9A.1, gt seq., the Township authorizes the establishment of a P-Card program.
- Section 3. The P-Card procedures and policies presented above are adopted as

 Township policies for the use of P-Cards, subject to Sections 4 & 5

 below.

- Section 4. The CFO, upon consultation with the Township Administrator and Program Manager, shall adopt additional policies and procedures as may be required to address the following, as per N.J.A.C. 5:30-9A.7(d):
 - A. Who may use a procurement card;
 - B. The documentation required to be submitted by authorized procurement card users to support transactions, including electronic funds transfers;
 - The training required before an individual is permitted to use a procurement card;
 - D. The types of transactions permitted;
 - E. The initial limits and procedure for establishing or revising limits in the future;
 - F. Encumbrance of limits assigned or amounts to be transferred electronically;
 - G. The penalties and disciplinary action to be assessed for improper use of a procurement card;
 - H. Who is to conduct supervisory reviews;
 - Procedures for contesting items appearing on the procurement card statement;
 - J. Procedures for collecting restitution resulting from misuse;
 - K. Reconciliation of activity; and
 - L. Requirements for distribution of funds to the issuer.
- Section 5. The CFO, upon consultation with the Township Administrator and Program Manager, may adopt additional policies and procedures, provided they are (1) required by law, regulation, or recommendation by the Local Finance Board, or (2) not inconsistent with the policies and procedures set forth in this Ordinance.
- Section 6. If any section, paragraph, sub-section, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof.
- Section 7. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township heretofore adopted that are inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PRIOR ORDINANCES CONTROLLING PUBLIC PARKING IN TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN TOWN HALL AND HEALTH DEPARTMENT PARKING LOTS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN that:

Section 1: Background & Findings

- A. The Township of North Bergen ("Township") has previously adopted ordinances, which regulate parking in certain Township parking lots, including those lots adjacent to Town Hall and those lots adjacent to the Township Health Department. See Ordinances 1140-08 (Health Department) and 1141-08 (Town Hall). These ordinances allow only Township officials and employees to park during Township works days, from 7:00 am to 5:00 pm, but allow the public to utilize designated lots during other days and times.
- B. The use of these lots by the public during designated times was intended to provide more non-commercial parking to North Bergen residents.
- C. In has been determined that these lots are frequently being used for commercial vehicles and by non-Township residents.
- D. The Township has determined it is necessary to further restrict the use of these lots to ensure their availability for North Bergen residents who own non-commercial vehicles.
- E. The Township has further adopted a Commercial Vehicle Parking Ordinance, No. 376-08 ("Commercial Vehicle Ordinance") and an Ordinance Controlling Permit Parking in the Township of North Bergen, No. 374-18 ("Permit Parking Ordinance"). The Commercial Vehicle Ordinance contains a definition of a "commercial vehicle," and the Permit Parking Ordinance provides for a system for the issuance of residential permits.

Section 2: Parking Lots Affected; Commercial Vehicles Barred; Residential Permits Required

- A. Those parking lots referenced in Ordinances 1140-08 (Health Department) and 1141-08 (Town Hall), where the public is permitted to park during specified days and times, shall be subject to the following additional restrictions:
 - 1. No "commercial vehicle," as defined in the Commercial Vehicle Ordinance, shall be permitted to park; and

2. Only vehicles having a residential permit issued by the North Bergen Parking Authority shall be permitted to park.

Section 3: Enforcement

The Parking Authority of the Township of North Bergen shall have and exercise the power and perform the duties associated with the management, operation and enforcement of this Ordinance. The North Bergen Police Department shall also enforce the provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 4: Violations, Penalties and Fines

Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of \$50.00 for the first offense, \$100.00 for the second offense, and \$150.00 for the third or subsequent offense.

Section 5: Severability

If any part or parts of this Ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 6: Repealer

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistency thereof.

Section 7: Effective Date:

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.
