Whereas, with her father's guidance she started to play percussion at the age of thirteen; and

Whereas, Parra later studied with Moris Cañate, her musical mentor and Rebolu bandmate, then enrolled at the Boys & Girls Harbor Conservatory in New York, where she studied and performed with both the Colombian and Latin Jazz ensembles under the direction of Pablo Mayor and Louis Bauzo; and

Whereas, a graduate of Berklee College of Music with a B.M. in Music Education, Parra has since worked and collaborated with FolkColombia, center for Traditional Music and Dance, Folklore Urbano, Gregorio Uribe Big Band, La Cumbiamba Eneye, Mestizo Dance Compan, Toto La Momposina, Sonia de Los Santos, Ruben Rodriguez, Miss Yaya and C&C Music Factory; and

Whereas, as a current drummer, Parra has performed at festivals and events such as Montreux Jazz Festival, Montana Folk Festival, Richmond Folk Festival, Lincoln Center Outdoors, Kennedy Center's Millennium Stage, Kimmel Center, SXSW, Mundial Montreal, Carnaval de Barranquilla, the Library of Congress, Getty Center, Hollywood Bowl, and many more; and

Whereas, she is currently teaching at Avenues: The World School. She was also one of the recording musicians for Disney's movie "Encanto," inspired in Colombia, in which Parra also won three Grammy Awards and One Oscars Award; and

Antonio Horta 1510 – 86th Street North Bergen, NJ 07047

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen recognize that handicapped drivers face unique difficulties in the location of parking spaces; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen have been empowered by N.J.S.A. 39:4-205 to restrict certain areas for handicapped parking; and

Section 4: This ordinance shall remain in effect for two (2) years ending December 31st of the second year from its effective date at which point it will expire and be of no further force or effect unless it is renewed for a further two (2) year period by formal resolution of the Board of Commissioners in accordance with Ordinance Nos. 1115-07 and 40-10.

Section 5: Any person who commits a violation of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of at least \$300.00 and up to 90 days of Community Service on such terms and in such form as the Municipal Court Judge deems appropriate or any combination thereof. BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION OF \$1,000,000 FOR SEWER IMPROVEMENTS ON 85TH STREET IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN, IN THE COUNTY OF HUDSON, NEW JERSEY, AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$1,000,000 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE TOWNSHIP TO FINANCE PART OF THE COST THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN, IN THE COUNTY OF HUDSON, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The improvement described in Section 3(a) of this bond ordinance has heretofore been authorized to be undertaken by the Township of North Bergen, in the County of Hudson, New Jersey (the "Township") as a general improvement. For the improvement or purpose described in Section 3(a), there is hereby appropriated the supplemental amount of \$1,000,000, such sum being in addition to the \$3,500,000 appropriated therefor by bond ordinance 579-23 of the Township, finally adopted January 25, 2023 (the "Original Bond Ordinance"). Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:2-11(c), no down payment is provided for the costs of the improvement or purpose since the improvement or purpose described in Section 3(a) hereof is being funded by the NJ I-Bank Water Financing Program.

Section 2. In order to finance the additional cost of the improvement or purpose not covered by application of the additional down payment, negotiable bonds are hereby authorized to be issued in the principal amount of \$1,000,000 pursuant to the Local Bond Law. In anticipation of the issuance of the bonds, negotiable bond anticipation notes are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to and within the limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. Section 3. (a) The improvement heretofore authorized and the purpose for the financing of which the bonds are to be issued is sewer improvements on 85th Street, consisting of the replacement and enlargement of the 15" diameter storm sewer line on 85th Street, between 2nd Avenue and JFK Boulevard to increase the hydraulic capacity of the drainage line conveying stormwater away from the intersection of 85th Street and 2nd Avenue and the replacement of the sanitary sewer line, as described in the Original Bond Ordinance, Including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto and further including all related costs and expenditures necessary therefor and incidental thereto.

(b) The estimated maximum amount of bonds or bond anticipation notes to be issued for the improvement or purpose is \$4,500,000, including the \$3,500,000 authorized by the Original Bond Ordinance and the \$1,000,000 bonds or bond anticipation notes authorized herein.

(c) The estimated cost of the improvement or purpose is \$4,500,000, including the \$3,500,000 appropriated by the Original Bond Ordinance and the \$1,000,000 appropriated herein.

Section 4. All bond anticipation notes issued hereunder shall mature at such times as may be determined by the chief financial officer; provided that no bond anticipation note shall mature later than one year from its date, unless such bond anticipation notes mature at such later date in accordance with applicable law. The bond anticipation notes shall bear interest at such rate or rates and be in such form as may be determined by the chief financial officer. The chief financial officer shall determine all matters in connection with bond anticipation notes issued pursuant to this bond ordinance, and the chief financial officer's signature upon the bond anticipation notes issued hereunder may be renewed from time to time subject to the provisions of the Local Bond Law or other applicable law. The chief financial officer is hereby authorized to sell part or all of the bond anticipation notes from time to time at public or private sale and to deliver them to the purchasers thereof upon receipt of payment of the purchase price plus accrued interest from their dates to the date of delivery thereof. The chief financial officer is directed to report in writing to the governing body at the meeting next succeeding the date when any sale or delivery of the bond anticipation notes pursuant to this bond ordinance is made. Such report must include the amount, the description, the interest rate and the maturity schedule of the bond anticipation notes sold, the price obtained and the name of the purchaser.

Section 5. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this bond ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 6. The following additional matters are hereby determined, declared, recited and stated:

(a) The improvement or purpose described in Section 3(a) of this bond ordinance is not a current expense. It is an improvement or purpose that the Township may lawfully undertake as a general improvement, and no part of the cost thereof has been or shall be specially assessed on property specially benefitted thereby.

(b) The period of usefulness of the improvement or purpose within the limitations of the Local Bond Law, according to the reasonable life thereof computed from the date of the bonds authorized by this bond ordinance, is 40 years.

(c) The Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly prepared and filed in the office of the Clerk, and a complete executed duplicate thereof has been filed in the office of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs of the State of New Jersey. Such statement shows that the gross debt of the Township as defined in the Local Bond Law is increased by the authorization of the bonds and notes provided in this bond ordinance by \$1,000,000, and the obligations authorized herein will be within all debt limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. (d) An aggregate amount not exceeding \$370,000 for items of expense listed in and permitted under N.J.S.A. 40A:2-20 is included in the estimated cost indicated herein for the purpose or improvement. Of this amount, \$270,000 was estimated for these items of expense in the Original Bond Ordinance and an additional \$100,000 is estimated therefor herein.

Section 7. The Township hereby declares the intent of the Township to issue bonds or bond anticipation notes in the amount authorized in Section 2 of this bond ordinance and to use the proceeds to pay or reimburse expenditures for the costs of the purposes described in Section 3(a) of this bond ordinance. This Section 7 is a declaration of intent within the meaning and for purposes of the Treasury Regulations.

Section 8. Any grant moneys received for the purpose described in Section 3 hereof shall be applied either to direct payment of the cost of the improvement or to payment of the obligations issued pursuant to this bond ordinance. The amount of obligations authorized but not issued hereunder shall be reduced to the extent that such funds are so used.

Section 9. The chief financial officer of the Township is hereby authorized to prepare and to update from time to time as necessary a financial disclosure document to be distributed in connection with the sale of obligations of the Township and to execute such disclosure document on behalf of the Township. The chief financial officer is further authorized to enter into the appropriate undertaking to provide secondary market disclosure on behalf of the Township pursuant to Rule 15c2-12 of the Securities and Exchange Commission (the "Rule") for the benefit of holders and beneficial owners of obligations of the Township and to amend such undertaking from time to time in connection with any change in law, or interpretation thereof, provided such undertaking is and continues to be, in the opinion of a nationally recognized bond counsel, consistent with the requirements of the Rule. In the event that the Township fails to comply with its undertaking, the Township shall not be liable for any monetary damages, and the remedy shall be limited to specific performance of the undertaking.

Section 10. The full faith and credit of the Township are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the obligations authorized by this bond ordinance. The obligations shall be direct, unlimited obligations of the Township, and the Township shall be obligated to levy *ad valorem* taxes upon all the taxable property within the Township for the payment of the obligations and the interest thereon without limitation of rate or amount.

Section 11. This bond ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE 2-YEAR EXTENSION OF A LEASE BETWEEN THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN (TENANT) & PLAZA PROFESSIONAL GROUP, LLC (LANDLORD) FOR A PORTION OF A BUILDING LOCATED AT 4219 BERGEN TURNPIKE IN THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN, NEW JERSEY

WHEREAS, the Township of North Bergen ("Township" or "Tenant") leases property owned by Plaza Professional Group, LLC ("Plaza" or "Landlord"), pursuant to a Lease Agreement, dated January 1, 2021, for property located at 4219 Bergen Turnpike, North Bergen, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the property is more specifically identified as area A in the building located at 4219 Bergen Turnpike, Block 113, Lot 1, on the official tax map of the Township (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Township uses the Property for storage purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Lease Agreement expired December 31, 2022, and the Township and the Landlord have agreed to extend the term for 2 additional years, with the rent remaining at \$1,200 per month for the first year and increasing to \$1,300 per month for the second year, with all other terms and conditions remaining the same; and

WHEREAS, the Township's extension of the lease of the Property from Plaza for the stated consideration is authorized by the Local Lands and Buildings Law, <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:12-3 & -5.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN as follows:

Section 1. The aforesaid recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.

Section 2. The Township's lease of the Property from Plaza for 2 additional years as set forth above is hereby authorized and approved.

Section 3. The Mayor, Township Administrator, Chief Financial Officer, Township Attorney, Township Clerk, Purchasing Agent, and any other necessary official, officer or employee of the Township be and they are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents and to take any and all actions necessary to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance, including the preparation and execution of an amendment to the Lease Agreement consistent with this Ordinance.

Section 4. If any section, paragraph, sub-section, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any other part thereof.

Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township heretofore adopted that are inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days from the time of its final passage.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF REAL PROPERTY ON DURHAM AVENUE, IDENTIFIED AS BLOCK 263, Lot 51 LOCATED BETWEEN BLOCK 263, Lot 48.02 (7501 DURHAM AVENUE) and BLOCK 263, LOT 52 (7431 DURHAM AVENUE) IN THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN

WHEREAS, the Township is the owner of certain land located on Durham Avenue, identified as Block 263, Lot 51, consisting of 873 square feet situated in the Township of North Bergen, County of Hudson, State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, a request has been made by an adjoining property owners to purchase the aforementioned property; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen has determined that such property is no longer needed for public use; and

WHEREAS, the Local Lands and Buildings Law (<u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:12-1 <u>et seq</u>.) provides for a private sale to the owner of real property contiguous to the real property being sold, provided that the property being sold is less than the minimum size required for development under the Municipal Zoning Ordinance and without any capital improvement thereon, except that when there is more than one owner with real property contiguous thereto, said property shall be sold to the highest bidder from among all such owners. Any such sale shall not be for less than the fair market value of the real property; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen has determined that the real property does not meet the minimum size required for development, that there are not capital improvements, and that the property has been appraised at a value of \$8,700.00; and

WHEREAS, the Township of North Bergen desires to dispose of this property in accordance with the provisions of <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:12-13(b)(5), by offering same for sale to the highest bidder of the contiguous property owners in a minimum amount of not less than \$8,700.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen as follows:

Section 1. The Township Administrator of the Township of North Bergen is hereby authorized to schedule an auction among the contiguous property owners for the following parcel of property:

Land located on Durham Avenue, identified as Block 263, Lot 51 located between Block 263, Lot 48.02 (7501 Durham Avenue) and Block 263, Lot 52 (7431 Durham Avenue) consisting of 873 square feet

- A. The Township Administrator of the Township of North Bergen is hereby authorized and directed to notify the contiguous property owners by certified and regular mail scheduling the auction no earlier than 30, nor later than 60 days, after adoption of this Ordinance.
- B. The minimum price that the property shall be offered for at the auction is \$8,700.00.
- C. The sale shall be "as is", and transfer of title shall take place within 45 days after the auction.

- D. On completion of the auction, the successful bidder will be required to provide a deposit of ten percent (10%) for the property by cash or certified check.
- E. Failure to comply with any of the above requirements, or to close within sixty (60) days after the award of the bid at auction, the Township of North Bergen shall be entitled to rescind the prior bid approval, and terminate any and all rights of its designated bidder of said property, and retain all monies theretofore deposited.
- F. The property is being conveyed subject to existing encumbrances, liens, zoning regulations, easements and other restrictions, such facts as an accurate survey will reveal, and any present or future assessment for the construction of improvements benefitting said property.
- G. The property shall merge with the existing lot owned by the successful bidder.

Section 2. If any section, paragraph, sub-section, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part thereof.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township heretofore adopted that are inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after final passage and adoption.
