AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND RATIFYING THE APPOINTMENT OF DEPUTY DIRECTORS BY THE SEPARATE DEPARTMENTS IN THE TOWNSHIP NORTH BERGEN

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN as follows:

Section 1. Background

- A. The commission form of government law, N.J.S.A. 40:70-1, et seq., and specifically N.J.S.A. 40:72-9, authorizes the board of commissioners, in their discretion, to provide by ordinance for the appointment of a deputy by each of the directors of the departments as may be deemed necessary for the proper and efficient conduct of the affairs of such departments.
- B. The Township of North Bergen ("Township") is a commission form of government, and all the Township Commissioners have historically appointed Deputy Directors, which have been referred to by varying titles such as "Deputy Director," "Confidential Aide to the Mayor," Confidential Aide to the Director," and "Confidential Aide".
- C. Prior Township ordinances reflect that the salary ranges for these positions were routinely set by ordinance of the Board of Commissioners, but the available Township records reveal that the positions of Deputy Director were created only in the Department of Public Safety, the Department of Public Works, and the Department of Revenue and Finance. Record of the creation of the position of Deputy Director in the Department of Public Affairs and the Department of Parks and Public Property could not be located.
- D. The Civil Service Commission presently has determined that the statutory Deputy Director position under N.J.S.A. 40:72-9 should be titled for Civil Service purposes as Deputy Municipal Department Head.

E. The Township Board of Commissions wishes to address these various inconsistencies in the historical Township ordinances, and clarify the title of the Deputy Director position from this time forward.

Section 2. Deputy Director Position

The appointment of a Deputy Director by each Director of the Township's Departments is hereby ratified, authorized and approved. For Civil Service purposes, the Deputy Director positions shall be known as Deputy Municipal Department Head, or such other title designation as the Civil Service Commission may determine to be appropriate in the future. Consistent with N.J.S.A. 40:72-9, the position shall be noncompetitive and unclassified for Civil Service purposes.

Section 3. Deputy Director Hours & Duties

<u>Pursuant to N.J.S.A.</u> 40:72-9, each Director shall prescribe, in writing, work hours and the powers and duties of the Deputy Director appointed by that Director.

Section 4. Severability

If any article, section, sub-section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason deemed to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 5. Repealer

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistency thereof. Prior Ordinances setting salaries for the titles by which Deputy Directors had been known in the Township are saved from repeal and continue to apply to the Deputy Director position.

Section 6. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.

AN ORDINANCE RE-ESTABLISHING A FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE POLICE SHOOTING RANGE AND SUPERSEDING ORDINANCE NOS. 161-13 AND 284-16

WHEREAS, the Township of North Bergen ("Township") has constructed a shooting range for use by the North Bergen Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Township wishes to update the fee schedule for making said range available for use by outside law enforcement agencies and professional law enforcement training organizations, which are certified in firearms training and methods of firearms instruction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN that:

Section 1: Fees for the use of the Township's shooting range shall be as follows:

- A. Weekends and Holidays
 - 1. A flat fee of \$300.00 per day, plus \$100.00 per hour.
- B. Regular Range Business Days
 - 1. A flat fee of \$300.00 per day.
 - 2. Where the range use in any one day exceeds 4 hours, there shall be an additional hourly fee for the time in excess of 4 hours, as follows:
 - a. During normal range business hours, the hourly rate shall be \$60.00.
 - b. During non-normal business hours, the hourly rate shall be \$100.00.
- C. The North Bergen Police Department shall determine the normal range business hours, which will consist of 8-hour days, Monday through Friday, except holidays.
- D. All hourly charges will be rounded up in 15 minute increments.

Section 2: The Chief of Police shall have discretion in granting and scheduling use of the range by outside law enforcement agencies and professional law enforcement training organizations that are certified in firearms training and methods of firearms instruction, but nothing herein shall be deemed to require any grant of use by the Chief of Police.

Section 3: The Chief of Police shall have discretion in waiving fees in exchange for professional training services rendered to the North Bergen Police Department when hosting firearms training. Said exchange of service shall be in writing and in compliance with the Local Public Contracts Law.

Section 4: Any agency or organization granted permission to use the range must, prior to use, provide the Township with a properly executed Use and Hold Harmless Agreement in a form satisfactory to the Township Attorney and proof of Liability Insurance Coverage in a minimum amount of One Million/Three Million Dollars.

Section 5: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistency thereof. Ordinance Nos. 161-13 and 284-16 are hereby repealed.

Section 6: If any part or parts of this ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 7: This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication as required by law.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF REAL PROPERTY KNOWN AS BLOCK 452.04, LOT 6.03, ALSO KNOWN AS 4400 WEST SIDE AVENUE ON THE OFFICIAL TAX MAP OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN.

WHEREAS, the Township is the owner of certain real property identified as Block 452.04, Lot 6.03, also known as 4400 West Side Avenue situated in the Township of North Bergen, County of Hudson, State of New Jersey consisting of approximately 1.44 acres; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen has determined that the property is not needed for any public use and should be sold for the public benefit; and

WHEREAS, the Local Lands and Buildings Law N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13 provides for a public sale at auction subject to allowable conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Township of North Bergen desires to dispose of this property in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13(a);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen as follows:

- **Section 1.** The Township Administrator of the Township of North Bergen is hereby authorized to schedule a public auction for sale to the highest bidder, after advertisement thereof, on the following real property:
 - (1) Block 452.04, Lot 6.03 also known as 4400 West Side Avenue.
 - A. The sales shall be "as is," and transfer of title shall take place within 30 days after the auction.

- B. On completion of the auction, the successful bidder will be required to provide a deposit of ten percent (10%) for the property by cash or certified check.
- C. In failure to comply with any of the above requirements, or to close within thirty (30) days after the award of the bid at auction, the Township of North Bergen shall be entitled to rescind the prior bid approval, and terminate any and all rights of its designated bidder of said property, and retain all monies theretofore deposited.
- D. The interest in the property being conveyed is subject to existing tenancies, encumbrances, liens, zoning regulations, easements and other restrictions, such facts as an accurate survey will reveal, and any present or future assessment for the construction of improvements benefitting said property. The successful bidder will be required to obtain all governmental permits and approvals for the proposed use of the property, including, but not limited to the New Jersey Sports & Exposition Authority.
- E. The minimum price shall be offered for the property at the auction is \$825,000.
- F. The Township shall remain in possession of the premises for one year from the closing date and continue to store vehicles and equipment thereon.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen recognize that handicapped drivers face unique difficulties in the location of parking spaces; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen have been empowered by N.J.S.A. 39:4-205 to restrict certain areas for handicapped parking; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 503-93, Ordinance No. 1115-07, Ordinance No. 40-10 and Ordinance No. 203-13 establish the terms and conditions for handicapped spaces.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen that:

Section 1: One restricted handicapped parking space be and hereby is established in front of the residence of Kathleen A. Carick of 9056 Palisade Plaza, Apt. # 1 and Juanita Marcano of 7427 Durham Avenue, North Bergen, N.J. 07047.

Section 2: The aforesaid space shall be used only by a motor vehicle displaying a permit issued by the North Bergen Police Department identifying the location of said handicapped parking space and the specific motor vehicle entitled to use same.

Section 3: The North Bergen Department of Public Works shall establish a restricted parking zone at the above location and shall erect a sign with the legend "Handicapped Parking for Resident Vehicle License Plate Number "S 6 7 G V P" for Kathleen A. Carick and "K 6 2 H E V" for Juanita Marcano, and this Ordinance Number.

Section 4: This ordinance shall remain in effect for two (2) years ending December 31st of the second year from its effective date at which point it will expire and be of no further force or effect unless it is renewed for a further two (2) year period by formal resolution of the Board of Commissioners in accordance with Ordinance Nos. 1115-07 and 40-10.

A separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which the violation continues.

TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN COUNTY OF HUDSON

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SPECIAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER POSITION AND COMPENSATION IN THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN, AND SUPERSEDING ORDINANCE 317-16

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN as follows:

Section 1. Background and Findings

- A. The Township of North Bergen ("Township") has determined that efficiencies in the Police Department can be further improved through the use of special law enforcement officers.
- B. <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:14-146.8, <u>et seq.</u>, the Special Law Enforcement Officers Act, authorizes a municipality, as it deems necessary, to appoint special law enforcement officers to perform the duties and responsibilities permitted by local ordinances and within the conditions and limitations established by law.
- C. The Township incurs costs related to special law enforcement officer training, education, uniforms, equipment, and the pre-employment process. A special law enforcement officer serving the Township less than 2 years results in a net cost increase, rather than a cost savings. In the event a special law enforcement officer leaves employment with the Township before 2 years of service, the Township should recoup all or part of its initial investment related to the appointment.

Section 2. Establishment of Class Two Special Law Enforcement Officer Position

There is hereby established the position of class two special law enforcement officer in the Township. Upon authorization of the Chief of Police, or his designee, officers of this class shall be authorized to exercise full powers and duties similar to those of a permanent, regularly appointed full-time police officer. The use of a firearm by an officer of this class may be authorized only after the officer has been fully certified as successfully completing training as prescribed by the Police Training Commission, established in the Department of Law and Public Safety pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:17B-70.

Section 3. Number of Class Two Positions Authorized

The number of class two special law enforcement officers shall not exceed 12.

Section 4. Eligibility & Qualifications

A. Determination of Eligibility. Before any special law enforcement officer is appointed, the Chief of Police shall ascertain the eligibility and qualifications of the applicant and report these determinations, in writing, to the Board of Commissioners.

B. Qualifications.

- 1. No person may be appointed as a special law enforcement officer unless the person:
 - a) Is at least eighteen (18) years of age;

- b) Is a resident of the State of New Jersey during the term of appointment;
- c) Is able to read, write and speak the English language well and intelligently and has a high school diploma or its equivalent;
- d) Is sound in body and of good health and is able to perform the physical functions of the duties assigned;
- e) Is of good moral character;
- f) Has not been convicted of any offense involving dishonesty or which would make him or her unfit to perform the duties of his or her office;
- g) Has successfully undergone the same psychological testing that is required of all full-time police officers in the Township; and
- h) Possesses a valid New Jersey drivers license.
- 2. Every applicant for the position of special law enforcement officer shall have fingerprints taken, which fingerprints shall be filed with the Division of State Police and the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

Section 5. Term of Appointment

Special law enforcement officers may be appointed for terms not to exceed one (1) year, and the appointments may be revoked by the Board of Commissioners for cause, after adequate hearing, unless the appointment is for four (4) months or less, in which event the appointment may be revoked without cause or hearing. Nothing herein shall be construed to require reappointment upon the expiration of the term. Special law enforcement officers so appointed shall not be members of the police force of the Township, and their powers and duties shall cease at the expiration of the term for which appointed.

Section 6. Training Course and Certification Requirements

No person may commence his or her duties as a special law enforcement officer unless he or she has successfully completed the training course and certification requirements of N.J.S.A. 40A:14-146.11, unless such training requirements have been waived by the Police Training Commission.

Section 7. Uniforms, Equipment & Firearms

- A. Every special law enforcement officer, prior to the commencement of his or her duties, shall be furnished with a uniform which shall identify the officer's function. The uniform shall include, but not be limited to, a hat and appropriate badges which shall bear an identification number or name tag and the name of the Township. The uniform shall also include an insignia issued by the Police Training Commission which clearly indicates the officer's status as a special law enforcement officer and the type of certification issued by the Police Training Commission. All special law enforcement officers prior to the commencement of duties shall be in uniform properly displaying the appropriate insignia.
- B. Whenever a special law enforcement officer's appointment is revoked or a special law enforcement officer is not reappointed upon the expiration of the term, the special law enforcement officer shall return to their supervisor all Township

issued uniforms, badges and equipment within fifteen (15) days of the revocation or expiration of the term.

C. Special law enforcement officers shall carry and return firearms pursuant to the guidelines established in N.J.S.A. 40A:146.14(b).

Section 8. Conduct of Special Law Enforcement Officers

- A. Special law enforcement officers shall comply with the rules and regulations applicable to the conduct and decorum of the permanent, regularly appointed police officers of the Township, as well as any rules and regulations applicable to the conduct and decorum of special law enforcement officers.
- B. Special law enforcement officers shall be under the supervision and direction of the Chief of Police and shall perform his or her duties only in the Township unless in fresh pursuit of any person pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2A:156-1, et seq.
- C. The Chief of Police, or his designee, may authorize special law enforcement officers, when on duty, to exercise the same powers and authority as permanent, regularly appointed police officers of the Township, including, but not limited to, the carrying of firearms and the power to arrest, subject to rules and regulations.
- D. Special law enforcement officers have no law enforcement authority while off-duty.

Section 9. Hours of Employment

The provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:14-146.16(a) and (c) regarding the maximum hours of employment of special law enforcement officers are hereby incorporated as if stated in full herein. Notwithstanding the foregoing, special law enforcement officers may only work a maximum of 24 hours per week, on a schedule to be determined by the commander of the Police Department Administrative Division.

Section 10. Limitation of Use of Officers

Special law enforcement officers may be employed only to assist the Township's law enforcement unit but may not be employed to replace or substitute for full-time regular police officers or in any way to diminish the number of full-time officers employed by the Township.

Section 11. Compensation

- A. The compensation for class two special law enforcement officers shall be not less than \$12.00 per hour, or more than \$25.00 per hour.
- B. Special law enforcement officers are not eligible for pensions, health benefits, paid sick leave, paid vacation or leave time, accrual of compensation time, or overtime pay.

Section 12. Separation of Service - Less than 2 Years

A. If a class two special law enforcement officer resigns or refuses reappointment such that his/her continuous service with the Township is for one year or less, that officer shall reimburse the Township for all the Township's costs related to appointing that officer, including, but not limited to, costs related to or arising out

of certification, training, education, uniforms, equipment, and the pre-employment process.

B. If a class two special law enforcement officer resigns or refuses reappointment such that his/her continuous service with the Township is for more than one year and less than two years, that officer shall reimburse the Township for 50% of all the Township's costs related to appointing that officer, including, but not limited to, costs related to or arising out of certification, training, education, uniforms, equipment, and the pre-employment process.

Section 13. Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistency thereof. Ordinance 317-16 is hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 14. Severability

If any part or parts of this Ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 15. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication as required by law.
