



WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen recognize that handicapped drivers face unique difficulties in the location of parking spaces; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen have been by empowered

N.J.S.A. 39:4-205 to restrict certain areas for handicapped parking; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 503-93, Ordinance No. 1115-07, Ordinance No. 40-10 and Ordinance No. 203-13 establish the terms and conditions for handicapped spaces.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen that:

Section 1: One restricted handicapped parking space be and hereby is established in front of the residence of Rose Clark of 1115 - 79th Street, Luis Martinez of 1001 Paterson Plank Rd and Francisco Sosa of 1202 – 8th Street, North Bergen, N.J. 07047.

Section 2: The aforesaid space shall be used only by a motor vehicle displaying a permit issued by the North Bergen Police Department identifying the location of said handicapped parking space and the specific motor vehicle entitled to use same.

Section 3: The North Bergen Department of Public Works shall establish a restricted parking zone at the above location and shall erect a sign with the legend "Handicapped Parking for Resident Vehicle License Plate Number "H M 7 2 8 4" for Rose Clark, "4 7 6 2 H F" for Luis Martinez and "H Y 9 3 8 6" for Francisco Sosa and this Ordinance Number.

Section 4: This ordinance shall remain in effect for two (2) years ending December 31st of the second year from its effective date at which point it will expire and be of no further force or effect unless it is renewed for a further two (2) year period by formal resolution of the Board of Commissioners in accordance with Ordinance Nos. 1115-07 and 40-10.

TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN HUDSON COUNTY, NEW JERSEY

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING MOBILE VIDEO BILLBOARDS AND AUDIO SOUND TRUCKS FROM THE STREETS AND HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN

WHEREAS, the Township of North Bergen, with a population of 60,773 persons and a land area of 5.134 square miles, is one of the most densely populated incorporated municipalities in the United States; and

WHEREAS, located on the cliff of the Palisades, North Bergen has the second most hills per square mile in the United States, second only to San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, North Bergen has 64.74 miles of roadways, of which 50.0 miles are maintained by the Township; and

WHEREAS, many of such streets are narrow and, by reason of the general topography, have a steep slope; and

WHEREAS, by reason of the narrow streets, steep slopes and the high population density, streets within the Township are heavily trafficked and congested, and lined with parked cars; and

WHEREAS, by reason of the foregoing, distracted drivers pose a particular hazard within the Township of North Bergen to both vehicular and pedestrian traffic; and

WHEREAS, mobile video billboards and audio sound trucks are particularly distracting to vehicle drivers and pedestrians and pose a peculiar and exceptional danger to the public's health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen finds that the prohibition of mobile video billboards and audio sound trucks from the streets and highways within the Township of North Bergen is a content neutral reasonable time, place and manner restriction on the exercise of speech which is the least restrictive means of addressing such distractions and the dangers posed to both motorists and pedestrians and is narrowly tailored to serve a significant government interest; and

WHEREAS, such a prohibition leaves open ample other alternative channels of communication available for communicating both commercial and non-commercial speech;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN, HUDSON COUNTY, NEW JERSEY as follows:

SECTION 1: Definitions.

"Audio sound truck" means a vehicle upon which an external sound system is installed to transmit a voice or sound message to the public outside the confines of the vehicle. "Emergency vehicle" means a vehicle owned and operated by an emergency service, such as police, fire, ambulance, public works or other governmental entity.

"Highway" means the entire width between the boundary lines of every way publicly maintained when any part thereof is open to the use of the public for purposes of vehicular travel.

"Mobile Video Billboard" means a vehicle upon which is displayed a digital image or an LED image which changes periodically or which appears to display a picture in motion.

"Motor vehicle" includes all vehicles propelled otherwise than by muscular power, excepting such vehicles as run only upon rails or tracks, lowspeed electric bicycles, low-speed electric scooters, and motorized bicycles.

"Operator" means a person who is in actual physical control of a vehicle.

"Pedestrian" means a person afoot.

"Street" means the same as highway.

"Vehicle" means every device in, upon or by which a person or property is or may be transported upon a highway, excepting devices moved by human power or used exclusively upon stationary rails or tracks or low-speed electric bicycles, low-speed electric scooters, or motorized bicycles.

SECTION 2: Prohibited Conduct.

- A. No person shall operate or permit to be operated a mobile video billboard, except for emergency vehicles, upon any public street within the Township of North Bergen or stand or park any mobile video billboard upon any public street while displaying a video image.
- B. No person shall operate or permit to be operated audio sound truck, except for emergency vehicles, upon any public street within the Township of North Bergen or stand or park any audio sound truck upon any public street while transmitting audio signals.

SECTION 3: Penalty.

- A. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a minimum fine of one hundred (\$100.00) dollars and a maximum fine not exceeding two thousand (\$2,000.00) dollars, for each offense.
- B. Any person who is convicted of violating this Ordinance within one year of the date of a previous violation of this Ordinance and who was fined for the previous violation, shall be sentenced by a court to an additional fine as a repeat offender. The additional fine imposed by the court upon a person for a repeated offense shall not be less than the minimum or exceed the maximum fine fixed for a violation of the Ordinance, but shall be calculated separately from the fine imposed for the violation of the Ordinance.

Severability. **SECTION 4:**

If any sentence, section, clause, or other portion of this Ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance, shall, for any reason, be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such judgment shall not affect, impair or repeal the remainder of the Ordinance.

Inconsistency. **SECTION 5:**

All Ordinances or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions hereof, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING RULES AND REGULATIONS, A FORM OF PERMIT APPLICATION AND A FORM OF AGREEMENT FOR ROAD OPENINGS AND RIGHT OF WAY OCCUPANCIES IN THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN that:

Section 1: Findings

- A. The Township of North Bergen ("Township") has received numerous requests and inquiries concerning road openings for various purposes and the installation of small cell antennas and related equipment within the Township rights of way.
- B. The Federal Telecommunications Act preserves local government's ability to manage the public rights of way on a competitively neutral and non-discriminatory basis, 47 U.S.C. 332 (c)(7)(A).
- C. New Jersey municipalities must give consent before a small cell antenna can be placed on existing poles pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 48:3-19 and for the erection of new poles within the public right of way pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 48:17-10.
- D. The Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") has recently adopted an order entitled "Accelerating Wireless Broadband Deployment by Removing Barriers to Infrastructure Investment; Accelerating Wireline Broadband Deployment by Removing Barriers to Infrastructure Investment" (the "FCC Order") WT Docket No. 17-79; WC Docket 17-84, which places a shot clock on municipal approval for the placement of small cell antennas on existing poles and the placement of new poles in the municipal right of way.
- E. The erection of new poles, antennas, and associated equipment within the public right of way raises significant aesthetic and safety concerns.
- F. The FCC Order provides that municipalities can impose aesthetic requirements on small cells where said requirements are: 1) reasonable; 2) no more burdensome than those applied to other types of infrastructure deployment; and 3) published in advance.
- G. The Township has determined that it is necessary to set forth clear standards in relation to road openings and the siting of poles, antennas and related equipment for the benefit of its citizens and any utilities which use or seek to use the public right of way for its facilities or equipment.
- H. In order to uniformly handle the processing and review of these requests, there is a need for the Township to adopt (1) rules and regulations governing road openings and rights of way occupancy; (2) a form application for rights of way occupancy permits; and (3) a form of right of way occupancy agreement.

Section 2: Adoption of Rules and Regulations, Permit Application Form and Agreement Form

A. On file in the Township Clerk's office are the following draft documents, dated August 14, 2019:

1. Proposed rules and regulations governing road openings and right of way occupancy;

2. A form application for a right of way occupancy permit; and

3. A form of right of way occupancy agreement.

B. The above rules and regulations, form of application, and form of agreement are hereby authorized and approved with such changes as the Township Administrator, Township Attorney, Special Counsel and Director of Community Development deem necessary to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance.

Section 3: Violations, Penalties and Fines

Any person, firm, corporation, municipal or private utility violating the rules and regulations adopted herein, or any permit or agreement for a road opening or right of way occupancy, shall be subject, upon conviction, to a fine not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per day for each and every day the violation exists, and civil action for the cost of prosecution as well as civil action for trespass to remove the non-conforming use.

Section 4: Severability

If any part or parts of this Ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 5: Repealer

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistency thereof.

Section 6: Effective Date:

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A REDEVELOPMENT PLAN AND DESIGNATING THE NORTH BERGEN HOUSING AUTHORITY AND THE NORTH BERGEN RENAISSANCE CORP. TO ACT AS THE REDEVELOPMENT ENTITY FOR THE REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR BLOCK 235, LOT 22, 6800 COLUMBIA AVENUE AND AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN TO ESTABLISH SPECIFIC DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS IN THIS AREA.

WHEREAS, a rehabilitation area designation analysis for Block 235, Lot 22 by Paul Grygiel, AICP, PP dated March, 2019 was prepared and submitted to the Planning Board; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Board recommended to the Board of Commissioners that Block 235 Lot 22 as more specifically delineated in the rehabilitation area designation analysis prepared by Paul Grygiel of Phillips, Preiss, Grygiel, Leheny Hughes LLC be determined by the Board of Commissioners to be a rehabilitation area; and

WHEREAS, the North Bergen Board of Commissioners accepted the recommendation of the Planning Board and designated the area an area in need of rehabilitation memorialized by Resolution adopted May 22, 2019; and

WHEREAS, a redevelopment plan has been prepared by Phillips Preiss Grygiel Leheny Hughes dated July, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the redevelopment plan provides a guide to the rehabilitation of this site and provides for development regulations and other standards; and

WHEREAS, Block 235, Lot 22 on the Tax Map of the Township of North Bergen, and generally described as one tax lot located between 67th Street, Grand Avenue, 69th Street and Liberty Avenue consisting of approximately 3.2 acres. The sole building within the redevelopment area is a senior citizen housing building known as Terrace Apartments owned by the North Bergen Housing Authority which consists of 11 stories and contains 252 dwelling units. The site is also improved with parking areas and other accessory uses related to the principal residential use. Block 235, Lot 22 has been declared by the Board of Commissioners, following the recommendation thereon by the Planning Board of the Township of North Bergen as an area in need of rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned block and lot is currently zoned as R-3

Moderate Density Residential District pursuant to the Zoning Ordinance Township of

North Bergen; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners found that there is an urgent need for additional senior housing units and this property is underutilized and has the potential useful to fill a public need and would be valuable for contributing to and servicing the public health, safety and welfare; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen in accordance with the provisions of *N.J.S.A.* 40A:12A-1 et seq. as follows:

Section 1. Designation of Block 235, Lot 22, 6800 Columbia Avenue Redevelopment Project: The Block 235, Lot 22, 6800 Columbia Avenue

Redevelopment Project on the Tax Map of the Township of North Bergen, and generally described as one tax lot whose boundaries are formed by the property lies of Block 235, Lot 22, is hereby declared and determined to be located within an area in need of rehabilitation in accordance with the provisions of *N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-14*.

Section 2. Designation of Redevelopment Entity. Pursuant to the authority granted by *N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-4c*, the North Bergen Housing Authority and the North Bergen Renaissance Corp. are hereby designated to exercise the powers of a redevelopment entity for the Block 235, Lot 22, 6800 Columbia Avenue Redevelopment Project.

Section 3. Redevelopment Plan. A Redevelopment Plan dated July, 2019 prepared by Phillips Preiss Grygiel Leheny Hughes LLC is incorporated herein by reference. The Plan includes the following:

A. Relationship to Local Objectives. The purpose of the Block 235, Lot 22, 6800 Columbia Avenue Redevelopment Project is to enhance and increase a necessary need for the Township, foster the proper utilization of existing resources, develop stagnant and unproductive land so as to render it useful and valuable for contributing to and servicing the public health, safety and welfare, providing for appropriate standards for buildings and other improvements to capitalize on the strengths of the redevelopment area, including its prime location, convenient road access and proximity to transit service and otherwise promote the public health, safety and welfare.

B. Proposed Land Uses. Land use proposed in the redevelopment plan shall consist of multifamily residential development.

The proposed development shall be designed so as to

- 1. Maximize appropriate land usage;
- Provide adequate off-street parking;
- 3. Create an attractive visual environment;
- 4. Provide other public improvements to carry out the foregoing purposes.
- C. Identification of Property and Redevelopment Area. The proposed redevelopment project consists of one tax parcel known as Block 235, Lot 22 on the Tax Map of the Township of North Bergen, and is generally described as one tax lot whose boundaries are formed by the property lines of Block 235, Lot 22.
- D. Relocation. Provisions for the temporary and permanent relocation of businesses and persons, if any, located within the redevelopment area shall be made in accordance with the New Jersey Relocation Assistance Law (*N.J.S.A. 52:31B-1 et seq.*) and the regulations adopted thereunder (*N.J.S.A. 5:11-1.1 et seq.*). The Township of North Bergen shall provide a workable relocation assistance plan for residents and businesses displaced as a result of the redevelopment plan. To the extent required by law, such workable relocation assistance plan shall include efforts to identify the persons and businesses displaced, determining the needs of relocation, providing assistance in relocating new places of residence and business within the Township of North Bergen and vicinity, provisions for the temporary and permanent relocation of

persons living in the redevelopment area by arranging for decent, safe and sanitary dwelling units at rents within the means of persons displaced from said area, and financial assistance for relocation and moving expenses.

- E. Relationship with Master Plan and Zoning Ordinance.
- With respect to the proposed land use and building requirements, the redevelopment plan is in conformity with the following provisions of the Township of North Bergen Master Plan and Re-Examination Reports:
- a. To expand the tax base to promote the economic well being of North Bergen and its residents.
- b. To promote safe and efficient circulation.
 - To promote the full economic potential of the land where commercial development is appropriate.
- 2. The Land Use Plan of the Master Plan designates the redevelopment area for transit-oriented residential and commercial land uses. By providing for the redevelopment area in this manner, the use is consistent with the Land Use Plan of the Master Plan.
- 3. The Board of Commissioners finds that the redevelopment plan is either substantially consistent with the master plan or it is designed to effectuate the master plan. To the extent that any portion of the redevelopment plan is inconsistent with or not designed to effectuate the master plan. The reasons therefor are set forth above.

F. Powers of Redevelopment Entity. Subject to the approval of the Board of Commissioners, the North Bergen Housing Authority and North Bergen Renaissance Corp. may proceed with the acquisition, clearance, rehabilitation, planning, reconstruction, renewal and redevelopment of the Block 235, Lot 22, 6800 Columbia Avenue Redevelopment Project and in order to carry out and effectuate said purposes, the Township of North Bergen may:

a. Acquire or contract to acquire from any person, firm, or corporation, public or private by contribution, gift, grant, bequest, devise, purchase, or otherwise, real or personal property or any interest therein, including such property as it may deem necessary or proper, although temporarily not required for such purposes, in the redevelopment area and in any area designated by the Board of Commissioners as necessary for carrying out the relocation of the residents, industry and commerce displaced from the redevelopment zone.

b.

Clear any area owned or acquired and install, construct or reconstruct streets, facilities, utilities and site improvement essential to the preparation of sites for use in accordance with the redevelopment plan.

C.

Lease, exchange or convey property or improvements to any such party pursuant to this section, without public building and at such prices and upon such terms as it deems reasonable, provided that the lease, exchange or conveyance is made in conjunction with the redevelopment

plan, notwithstanding the provisions of any law, rule, or regulation to the contrary.

d.

Make, consistent with the redevelopment plan: (1) plans for carrying out a program of voluntary repair and rehabilitation of buildings and improvements; and (2) plans for the enforcement of law, codes, and regulations relating to the use and occupancy of buildings and improvements, and to the compulsory repair, rehabilitation, demolition, or removal of buildings and improvements.

e.

Dispose of land so acquired at its fair value for the uses specified in the redevelopment plan as determined by it to any person, firm, or corporation or to any public agency by sale, lease, or exchange.

f.

Request the Planning Board to recommend pursuant to existing law the designation of additional areas in need of redevelopment or rehabilitation and to make recommendations for such redevelopment or rehabilitation of such areas.

g.

To study the recommendations of the Planning Board for redevelopment of any area and to make its own investigations and recommendations as to current trends in the Township, blighted areas and blighted factors.

h.

To publish and disseminate information.

i.

To prepare or arrange by contract for the provisions of professional service and the preparation of plans by registered architects or licensed

professional engineers or planners or other consultants for the carrying out of the redevelopment project.

j.

To arrange or contract with public agencies or redevelopers for the planning, replanning, construction, or undertaking of any project or development work, on any part thereof, to provide as part of any such arrangement or contract for extension of credit or making of loans to redevelopers to finance any project or redevelopment work, and to arrange or contract with public agencies for the opening, grading or closing of streets, roads, roadways, alleys or other places or for the furnishing of facilities or for the acquisition by such agency of property options or property rights or for the furnishing of property or services in connection with a redevelopment area.

k.

To arrange or contract with a public agency, to the extent that it is within the scope of that agency's functions, to cause the services customarily provided by such other agency to be rendered for the benefit of the occupants of the redevelopment area, and to have such other agency provide and maintain parks, recreation centers, schools, sewerage, transportation, water and other municipal facilities adjacent to or in connection with redevelopment areas.

To enter upon any building or property in the redevelopment area in order to conduct investigations or make surveys, soundings, or test

borings necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

m.

To arrange or contract with a public agency for the relocation of residents, industry or commerce displaced from the redevelopment area.

- n. To conduct examinations and investigations, hear testimony and make proof, under oath at public or private hearings of any material matter, require the attendance of witnesses and the production of books and papers and issue commissions for the examination of witnesses who are out of State, unable to attend, or excused from attendance.
- o. To authorize a committee designated by it consisting of one or more members, or counsel, or any officer or employee to conduct any such investigation or examination, in which case such committee, counsel, officer or employee shall have power to administer oaths, take affidavits and issue subpoenas or commission.
- p. To do all things necessary or convenient to carry out its powers.
- q. To negotiate with redevelopers for the private sale of real property within the redevelopment area; and
- r. To do and perform all powers authorized by Law to carry out the foregoing purposes not otherwise specifically limited herein.

Section 4. Miscellaneous Provisions

A. The Mayor is hereby designated to execute and the Township Clerk to attest, any and all documents necessary to carry out any of the purposes set forth in this ordinance, all of a form approved by the Special Counsel.

Section 5. The Zoning Ordinance of the Township of North Bergen is hereby amended and supplemented to implement the redevelopment plan as follows:

Principal Permitted Uses:

Multifamily residential dwelling units including senior,
 supportive and/or affordable housing

Accessory Uses:

Other uses customarily accessory to the principal use, including off-street parking and loading areas, and residential amenities customarily incidental to the principal permitted use..

Area and Bulk Regulations:

a. Minimum Lot Area Three Acres
b. Maximum Building Height: Four residential stories over one

parking level applicable to new buildings

c. Minimum Yard Setbacks:

Front Yard Zero (-0-) Feet

Side Yard 10 feet

f. Maximum Building Coverage: 25 percent

g. Maximum Lot Coverage: 65 percent

h. Off-street Parking: 0.45 parking space per unit

Other Standards:

- a. The intent of the Plan is to provide a high-quality, multi-family dwelling that retains the scale of the existing neighborhood while offering additional housing options based on the site's proximity to transit, stores, and services areas. Any building should be similar in height and prevailing setback to those in the immediately surrounding area. Accessory architectural features such as porches and balconies shall be permitted in accordance with the Zoning Ordinance of the Township of North Bergen.
- b. Lighting: Adequate lighting shall be provided for all parking area and pedestrian walkways. All lighting of out-door parking areas shall confirm to Section 7.1.b(4) of the Township of North Bergen Zoning Ordinance, which sets forth the lighting and design standards for off-street parking area.
- Sidewalks: Sidewalks shall be provided in order to facilitate safe
 pedestrian access between all buildings, parking areas and public
 sidewalks. The minimum width of sidewalks shall be four (4) feet.
- d. Recycling and Refuse Areas: One or more designated areas shall be provided for the storage of recyclables and refuse. Such areas shall be located within a building or enclosures.
- e. Signage: Signage shall be governed by Section 5.4 of the Township of North Bergen Zoning Ordinance.
- f. Building Facade Design: Large horizontal buildings shall be broken into

segments having vertical orientation. Architectural elements and design variation, including building offsets, shall be integrated to preclude qa continuous uninterrupted facade.

g. Parking and Circulation Design: parking shall be permitted in required yards. Other parking regulations shall be governed by Section 7.1 of the Township of North Bergen Zoning Ordinance.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect after publication and passage according to law.

Section 7. The Township Clerk is hereby directed to give notice at least ten days prior to the hearing on the adoption of this ordinance to the Hudson County Planning Board, and to all others entitled thereto pursuant to the provisions of *N.J.S.A.* 40:55D-15. Upon adoption of this ordinance, after public hearing thereon, the Township Clerk is further directed to publish notice of the passage thereof and to file a copy of this ordinance as finally adopted with the Hudson County Planning Board as required by *N.J.S.A.* 40:55D-16 and with the Township Tax Assessor.

Section 8. Should any section, part or provision of this ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any other part thereof.

Section 9. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. Specifically Ordinance No. 234-14 adopted December 23, 2014 is hereby repealed.

Section 10. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon publication and

final passage according to law.
