He has managed the philanthropic agenda of multi-platinum recording artist, Romeo Santos, and his manager, Johnny Marinos, which services many disadvantaged Latino and African American communities in New Jersey and New York City; and

WHEREAS, Alexander, has also been active in Boston Consulting Group Bridge to Consulting, North Hudson Community Action Corporation, Mentorship and Leadership Acquisition Program, Committee on Undergraduate Instruction, Harvard Classics Men's Club Basketball Team, and

WHEREAS, Alexander, is a Rhodes Scholar and intends to pursue a Masters of Public Policy and a Masters in Evidence-Based Social Intervention and Policy Evaluation at the University of Oxford. After completing his graduate studies at Oxford University, Alexander plans to continue his studies in the United States pursuing a dual degree, Juris Doctor/Masters in Business Administration; and

WHEREAS, Alexander, has been awarded the Mack I. Davis Memorial Prize, Phi Beta Kappa Patricia King Research Fellowship, Edward J. Bloustein NJ Distinguished Scholar, Scholar for the National Hispanic Recognition Program; and as a result of his considerable accomplishments and exemplary dedication to excellence, Alexander J. Diaz, has brought honor and pride to his family and his community.
