WHEREAS, Across the nation, traffic crashes caused approximately 32,675 (est.) fatalities in 2014, and are the leading cause of death for young people ages 15 to 34; and,

WHEREAS, In New Jersey, 556 individuals lost their lives in traffic crashes in 2015; and,

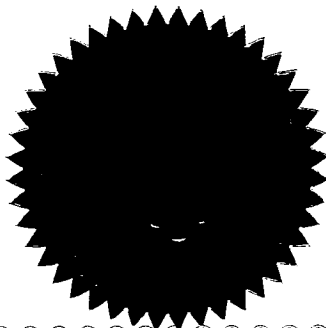
WHEREAS, Alcohol-related crashes accounted for 27.0 percent of the State's traffic fatalities, while 26 percent of all fatal crashes involved traveling at unsafe speeds; and,


WHEREAS, Motorcyclists, bicycle riders and pedestrians face increased risks on New Jersey's roadways, as people opt for alternative modes of transportation; and,

WHEREAS, 60 motorcyclists, 11 bicyclists and 170 pedestrians were killed in New Jersey in traffic-related fatalities in 2015; and,

WHEREAS, Safer driving behaviors such as buckling up, every ride; obeying posted speed limits; stopping for pedestrians in crosswalks and using crosswalks when walking; avoiding aggressive driving behaviors; never driving impaired; wearing proper safety gear when riding a motorcycle or bicycle; and focusing solely on driving by avoiding distractions, can dramatically reduce the number of traffic-related injuries and deaths.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, NICHOLAS J. SACCO, MAYOR OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN, COUNTY OF HUDSON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, do hereby proclaim October 10, 2015, "Put the Brakes on Fatalities Day®", and call upon everyone to put these lifesaving behaviors into practice to improve safety on the roadways in our community and throughout the State.



WHEREAS, the Hispanic Community represents more than fifty percent of the Township of North Bergen; and

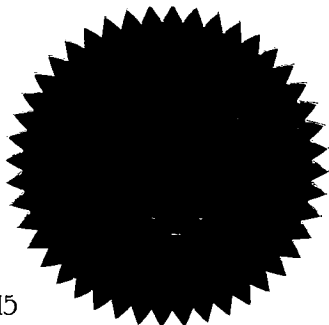
WHEREAS, members of the Hispanic Community contribute in the areas of business, community service and public office to keep North Bergen moving forward; and



WHEREAS, due to several road and bridge projects in the area of Paterson Plank Road, Tonnelle Avenue (U.S. Routes 1&9), West Side Avenue, 36th Street, 34th Street and Dell Avenue, the present configuration of roads does not match the Township of North Bergen ("Township") Tax maps, and the areas maintained by the State of New Jersey, Department of Transportation ("DOT"), the County of Hudson ("County") and the Township are inconsistent with what these entities actually own based on County Register records and official tax maps; and

WHEREAS, part of the road and bridge projects involved DOT's construction of Ramps C and D providing access between Paterson Plank Road and Tonnelle Avenue; and

WHEREAS, on the Township tax maps, a portion of 34th Street lies west of Tonnelle Avenue, and within Ramp C and the Ramp C infield; and

WHEREAS, as a result, there is a need for the County and the Township to exchange certain property, for the DOT to grant certain easements to the County and Township, and for the DOT, County and Township to clarify the public record so that the public entity owners of record and the official tax maps are consistent with which public entity is actually responsible for the repair and maintenance of various roads and properties in and around Ramp C; and
