



AN ORDINANCE TO ALLOW FOR THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF 88TH STREET IN THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN

WHEREAS, 88th Street is a public street in the Township of North Bergen, County of Hudson, State of New Jersey, shown on the Official Map of the Township of North Bergen; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid portion of 88th Street appears on the Tax Map as being 45 feet in width and is presently a developed thoroughfare; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the development of a shopping center on the westerly side of Tonnelle Avenue, 88th Street was realigned with the existing 88th Street on the easterly side of Tonnelle Avenue and a portion of 88th Street on the western side of Tonnelle Avenue should be vacated; and

WHEREAS, the Township's Engineer, Boswell Engineering, the Township's Traffic Consultant, Dolan & Dean, and the North Bergen Police Department has reviewed the request and have indicated that the street vacation would be appropriate; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen, after due investigation and consideration have determined that the nature and extent of the public use and the public interest to be served is such as to warrant the vacation of that portion of 88th Street as described in this ordinance and that the vacation would relieve the public from the course of maintaining said portion of 88th Street, and the vacation would benefit the health, welfare and public safety of the citizens of the Township of North Bergen.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN that:

Section 1. All that portion of 88th Street described below is hereby vacated and the public rights in and to such public street are hereby released and extinguished.

The portion of 88th Street to be vacated being more particularly described on the plan entitled *Plan of Northern Portion of 88th Street Description*, prepared by Langan Engineering & Environmental Services, dated December 22, 2014 and plan entitled *Plan of the Southern Portion of 88th Street Description*, prepared by Langan Engineering & Environmental Services dated December 22, 2014 attached hereto as Schedule "A" and the metes and bounds descriptions of the property prepared by Langan Engineering & Environmental Services dated December 29, 2014 and December 22, 2014 respectively, attached hereto as Schedule "B".

<u>Section 2.</u> The Official Map of the Township of North Bergen is hereby amended to indicate that portion of 88th Street as vacated as particularly described above.

<u>Section 3.</u> The portion of 88th Street which is set forth on the metes and bounds description above within the Township of North Bergen, is hereby vacated as a public reservation, and the rights of the public therein are hereby released and extinguished, except all rights and privileges then possessed by Public Utilities, as defined in <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 48:2-13, and by any cable television company, as defined in the "Cable Television Act", P.L. 1972, C. 186 (<u>N.J.S.A.</u> 48:5A-1 et seq.), the Township of North Bergen, the North Bergen Municipal Utilities Authority and their successors, to maintain, repair, and replace existing facilities in, adjacent to, over or under the portion

of 88th Street to be vacated.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistency thereof.

Section 5. If any article, section, sub-section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason deemed to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not effect the remaining portion of this ordinance.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect upon the publication as required by law.







TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN

WHEREAS, the Township of North Bergen adopted a comprehensive Zoning Ordinance on June 23, 1999; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners requested the Planning Board of the Township of North Bergen to review the current Zoning Ordinance relating to retail convenience uses, and signage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen as follows:

Section 1. Definitions of the Township of North Bergen Zoning Ordinance is amended and supplemented by adding the following definitions:

- a. <u>Convenience Retail with Fuel Dispensing</u> A retail establishment offering a wide array of convenience items such as prepackaged and fresh food products, newspapers, magazines and other household items, including facilities for the sale and dispensing of fuel and services as a single use even if conducted from multiple detached buildings.
- b. <u>Restaurants</u> A place of business where food and drink are prepared and picked up, or consumed while patrons are seated at tables in the premises.
- c. <u>Retail Food Establishment</u> An establishment where food and beverages are offered for retail sale for consumption off premises. Such foods or beverages may be packaged in a ready-to-consume state or may come packaged and sold in bulk quantities. Examples of retail food establishments include, without limitation, grocery stores, ice cream shops, retail mini-marts, bakeries and delicatessens.
- d. <u>Retail Sales</u> Establishments engaged in selling goods or merchandise to the general public for personal or household consumption and rendering services incidental to the sale of such goods, including, but not limited to specialty shops and boutiques.

- **Section 2**. Article VI Conditional Use Standards. The Township of North Bergen Zoning Ordinance is amended and supplemented as follows:
 - 6.3(f) Service Stations and Convenience Retail with Fuel Dispensing
 - (1) <u>Location of Exits and Entrances</u>. No gasoline filling station, or any vehicular access thereto shall be located within 100 feet of the following uses if on the same street and block:
 - Schools
 - Playgrounds
 - Churches

Vehicular access to the above automotive uses shall not be closer than 30 feet to the intersection of any two streets.

- **Section 3**. Article V Signs. The Township of North Bergen Zoning Ordinance is amended and supplemented as follows:
 - 5.4(a)(5) Number of Signs Not more than one freestanding sign may be placed on a property, unless such property fronts upon more than one street, in which event two freestanding signs may be erected, one upon each of two frontages. In the event the property has eight hundred feet of frontage on one road or has a number of entrances or exits, the Construction Code Official or Planning Board may authorize the placement of additional signs. One sign panel of no greater than 50 square feet shall be permitted to be affixed to such freestanding sign. An additional 50 square feet may be provided in connection with the following uses:
 - pharmacy
 - service station
 - convenience retail with fuel sales
 - Retail food sales

5.4(c)(2) <u>Illuminated Signs</u> - All lighted signs, with the exception of signs required by law in connection with the advertising of fuel prices, shall be indirectly illuminated so that such light source is properly shielded from residences and streets.

Section 4. The Township Clerk is hereby directed to give notice at least ten (10) days prior to the hearing on the adoption of this ordinance to the Hudson County Planning Board, and to all others entitled thereto pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40:55D-15. Upon adoption of this ordinance, after public hearing thereon, the Township Clerk is further directed to publish notice of this passage thereof and to file a copy of this ordinance as finally adopted with the Hudson County Planning Board as required by N.J.S.a. 40:55D-16 and with the Township Tax Assessor.

Section 5. Should any section, part or provision of this ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any other part thereof.

Section 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen recognize that handicapped drivers face unique difficulties in the location of parking spaces; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen have been empowered by

N.J.S.A. 39:4-205 to restrict certain areas for handicapped parking; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 503-93, Ordinance No. 1115-07, Ordinance No. 40-10 and Ordinance No. 203-13 establish the terms and conditions for handicapped spaces.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen that:

Section 1: One restricted handicapped parking space be and hereby is established in front of the residence of Cumanda Lopez of 7417 – 2nd Avenue, 1st Floor, Maria C. Orozco of 6923 Liberty Avenue, Apt. # 2 and Roger Perez of 8300 – 2nd Avenue, Apt. # 1, North Bergen, N.J. 07047.

Section 2: The aforesaid space shall be used only by a motor vehicle displaying a permit issued by the North Bergen Police Department identifying the location of said handicapped parking space and the specific motor vehicle entitled to use same.

Section 3: The North Bergen Department of Public Works shall establish a restricted parking zone at the above location and shall erect a sign with the legend "Handicapped Parking for Resident Vehicle License Plate Number "7 1 8 8 H B" for Cumanda Lopez, "2 4 2 5 H B" for Maria C. Orozco and "J S E 8 8 H" for Roger Perez, and this Ordinance Number.

Section 4: This ordinance shall remain in effect for two (2) years ending December 31st of the second year from its effective date at which point it will expire and be of no further force or effect unless it is renewed for a further two (2) year period by formal resolution of the Board of Commissioners in accordance with Ordinance Nos. 1115-07 and 40-10.

Section 5: Any person who commits a violation of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of at least \$300.00 and up to 90 days of Community Service on such terms and in such form as the Municipal Court Judge deems appropriate or any combination thereof. A separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which the violation continues.

Section 6: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistency thereof.

Section 7: If any part or parts of this ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.
