RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING LICENSE AGREEMENTS WITH DILIGENT URGENT CARE, LLC AND KENNEDY BUSINESS CENTER LLC TO ENABLE ADDITIONAL COVID-19 TESTING IN THE TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, the Township of North Bergen and Diligent Urgent Care, LLC ("Diligent") had been parties to a License Agreement, dated May 30, 2020, as amended (the "Diligent License Agreement"), pursuant to which Diligent provided Covid-19 testing at various locations within the Township; and

WHEREAS, in conjunction with the Diligent License Agreement, the Township had entered various other license agreements to obtain access rights to locations from which Diligent could conduct testing, including with Kennedy Business Center, LLC (the Kennedy Business Center License Agreement") for testing at the parking lot located at 2416, 2418 & 2500 Meadowview Ave., North Bergen (the "Meadowview Ave. Parking Lot"); and

WHEREAS, the Township, Diligent and Kennedy Business Center wish to revive their respective license agreements so that Diligent may resume Covid-19 testing due to the surge of the Covid – 19 Delta variant; and

WHEREAS, in order to revive the testing, the Diligent License Agreement and the Kennedy Business Center License Agreement will need to be amended; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the amended license agreements, the Township will obtain a license from Kennedy Business Center for the use of the Meadowview Ave. Parking Lot without cost to the Township, and the Township will in turn grant a license to Diligent to conduct testing at the Meadowview Ave. Parking Lot site; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Diligent License Agreement, as amended,

(1) Diligent will provide both swab and antibody Covid – 19 and related testing
to North Bergen residents on a priority basis by appointment, (2) that no resident

will have to pay out of pocket for the testing, and (3) that the Township will pay Diligent for certain Township residents at a rate of \$85 per test; and

WHEREAS, the Diligent License Agreement will authorize the Township to relocate Diligent to other sites within the Township, and because the Township may need to obtain the rights to additional locations for testing, there is the need to authorize the Township Administrator to obtain rights with additional property owners or lessees to enable testing on their property; and

WHEREAS, the actions set forth herein are authorized pursuant to the emergency contracting provisions in N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6 and N.J.A.C. 5:34-6.1 and the professional services bidding exception, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)a.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN, that:

- 1. The aforesaid recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.
- 2. The Township Administrator and Township Attorney are hereby authorized to prepare amendments to the Diligent License Agreement and the Kennedy Business Center License Agreement consistent with this Resolution.
- 3. The Township Administrator and Township counsel are hereby authorized to enter agreements with other Township property owners or lessees in order to enable the mobile testing provided for in the Diligent License Agreement at other locations.
- 4. The Mayor, Township Administrator, Chief Financial Officer, Township counsel, Township Clerk, Township Purchasing Agent, Township Health Officer, and any other necessary official, officer or employee of North Bergen be and they are hereby authorized to take any and all actions necessary to complete and realize the intent and purpose of this Resolution, including the preparation and execution of any agreements to effectuate the purposes set forth in this Resolution.
- 5. A certified copy of this Resolution be forwarded to Diligent Urgent Care and Kennedy Business Center.

AGREEMENT FOR PAYMENT IN LIEU OF TAXES

North Bergen Supportive Housing, HMFA #(s)_____

THIS AGREEMENT, made this day of July 2019, between North Bergen Renaissance Supportive Housing, LP, a limited partnership, of the State of New Jersey, having its principal office at One Parker Plaza, Fort Lee, New Jersey 07024 (hereinafter the "Sponsor") and the Township of North Bergen, a municipal corporation in the County of Hudson and State of New Jersey (hereinafter the "Municipality").

WINESSETH

In consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained and for other good and valuable consideration, it is mutually covenanted and agreed as follows:

- 1. This Agreement is made pursuant to the authority contained in Section 37 of the New Jersey Housing and Mortgage Finance Agency Law of 1983 (N.J.S.A. 55: 14K-1 et seq.) (hereinafter "HMFA Law") and a Resolution of the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen dated ______, 2019, (the "Resolution") and with the approval of the New Jersey Housing and Mortgage Finance Agency (hereinafter the "Agency"), as required by N.J.S.A. 55: 14K-37.
- 2. The Project is or will be situated on that parcel of land designated as Block 235, Lot 22 as shown on the Official Assessment Map of the Township of North Bergen, and more commonly referred to as 6725 Columbia Avenue, North Bergen, Hudson County, New Jersey.
- As of the date the Sponsor executes a first mortgage upon the Project in favor of the Agency (hereinafter referred to as the "Agency Mortgage"), the land and improvements comprising the Project shall be exempt from real property taxes, provided that the Sponsor shall make payments in lieu of taxes to the Municipality as provided hereinafter. The exemption of the Project from real property taxation and the sponsor's obligation to make payments in lieu of taxes shall not extend beyond the date on which the Agency Mortgage is paid in full, which, according to the HMFA Law, may not exceed fifty (50) years.
- 4. (a) For projects receiving construction and permanent financing from the Agency, the Sponsor shall make payment to the Municipality of an annual service charge in lieu of taxes in such amount as follows:

- (1) From the date of the execution of the Agency Mortgage until the date of substantial completion of the Project, the Sponsor shall make payment to the municipality in an amount equal to the amount of taxes due on the property for the year preceding the recording of the Agency Mortgage. As used herein, "Substantial Completion" means the date upon which the Municipality issues the Certificate of Occupancy for all units in the Project.
- (2) From the date of Substantial Completion of the Project and for the remaining term of the NJHMFA Mortgage, the Sponsor shall make payment to the Municipality in an amount equal to 6.28 percent of Project Revenues.
- (b) For Projects receiving permanent financing only from the Agency, the Sponsor shall make payment to the Municipality in an amount equal to 6.28 percent of Project Revenues from the date of the Agency Mortgage and for the remaining term of the Agency Mortgage.
- (c) As used herein, "Project Revenues" means the total annual gross rental or carrying charge and other income of the Sponsor from the Project less the costs of utilities furnished by the Project, which shall include the costs of gas, electricity, heating fuel, water supplied, and sewage charges, and less vacancies if any. Project Revenues shall not include any rental subsidy contributions received from any federal or state program.
- (d) The amount of payment in lieu of taxes to be paid pursuant to paragraphs (a) or (b) and (c) above is calculated in Exhibit "A" attached hereto. It is expressly understood and agreed that the revenue projections provided to the Municipality as set forth in Exhibit "A" and as part of the Sponsor's application for an agreement for payments in lieu of taxes are estimates only. The actual payments in lieu of taxes to be paid by the Sponsor shall be determined pursuant to Section 5 below.
- 5. (a) Payments by the Sponsor shall be made on a quarterly basis in accordance with bills issued by the Tax Collector of the Municipality in the same manner and on the same dates as real estate taxes are paid to the Municipality and shall be based upon Project Revenues of the previous quarter. No later than three (3) months following the end of the first fiscal year of operation after (i) the date of Substantial Completion (for projects receiving construction and permanent financing) or (ii) the date of the Agency Mortgage (for projects receiving permanent financing only) and each year thereafter that this Agreement remains in effect, the Sponsor shall submit to the Municipality a certified, audited financial statement of the operation of the Project (the "Audit"), setting forth the Project Revenues and the total payments in lieu of taxes due to the Municipality calculated at 6.28 percent of Project Revenues as set forth in the Audit (the "Audit Amount"). The Sponsor simultaneously shall pay the difference, if any, between (i) the Audit Amount and (ii) payments made by the Sponsor to the Municipality for the preceding fiscal year. The Municipality may accept any such payment without prejudice to its right to challenge the amount due. In the event that the payments made by the Sponsor for any fiscal year shall exceed the Audit Amount for such

fiscal year, the Municipality shall credit the amount of such excess to the account of the Sponsor.

- (b) All payments pursuant to this Agreement shall be in lieu of taxes and the Municipality shall have all the rights and remedies of tax enforcement granted to Municipalities by law just as if said payments constituted regular tax obligations on real property within the Municipality. If, however, the Municipality disputes the total amount of the annual payment in lieu of taxes due it, based upon the Audit, it may apply to the Superior Court, Chancery Division for an accounting of the service charge due the Municipality, in accordance with this Agreement and HMFA Law. Any such action must be commenced within one year of the receipt of the Audit by the Municipality.
- (c) In the event of any delinquency in the aforesaid payments, the Municipality shall give notice to the Sponsor and NJHMFA in the manner set forth in 9(a) below, prior to any legal action being taken.
- 6. The tax exemption provided herein shall apply only so long as the Sponsor or its successors and assigns and the Project remain subject to the provisions of the HMFA Law and Regulations made thereunder and the supervision of the Agency, but in no event longer than the term of the Agency Mortgage. In the event of (a) a sale, transfer or conveyance of the Project by the Sponsor or (b) a change in the organizational structure of the Sponsor, this Agreement shall be assigned to the Sponsor's successor and shall continue in full force and effect so long as the successor entity qualifies under the HMFA Law or any other state law applicable at the time of the assignment of this Agreement and is obligated under the Agency Mortgage.

Upon the payment in full of the Agency Mortgage, the Sponsor or its successor, as applicable, shall give notice to the Municipality within ten (10) business days of the date the Agency Mortgage is paid.

- 7. Upon any termination of such tax exemption, whether by affirmative action of the Sponsor, its successors and assigns, or by virtue of the provisions of the HMFA Law, or any other applicable state law, the Project shall be taxed as omitted property in accordance with the law.
- 8. The Sponsor, its successors and assigns shall, upon request, permit inspection of property, equipment, buildings and other facilities of the Project and also documents and papers by representatives duly authorized by the Municipality. Any such inspection, examination or audit shall be made during reasonable hours of the business day, in the presence of an officer or agent of the Sponsor or its successors and assigns.
- 9. Any notice or communication sent by either party to the other hereunder shall be sent by certified mail, return receipt requested, addressed as follows:
- (a) When sent by the Municipality to the Sponsor, it shall be addressed to Joseph Alpert, One Parker Plaza, Fort Lee, New Jersey 07024 or to such other address as the Sponsor may hereafter designate in writing and a copy of said notice or communication by the Municipality to the Sponsor shall be sent by the Municipality to

the New Jersey Housing and Mortgage Finance Agency, 637 South Clinton Avenue, P.O. Box 18550, Trenton, New Jersey 08650-2085.

- (b) When sent by the Sponsor to the Municipality, it shall be addressed to the Office of the Township Administrator. Township of North Bergen, 4233 Kennedy Boulevard, North Bergen, New Jersey 07047 or to such other address as the Municipality may designate in writing; and a copy of said notice or communication by the Sponsor to the Municipality shall be sent by the Sponsor to the New Jersey Housing and Mortgage Finance Agency, 637 South Clinton Avenue, P.O. Box 18550, Trenton, New Jersey 08650-2085.
- 10. In the event of a breach of this Agreement by either of the parties hereto or a dispute arising between the parties in reference to the terms and provisions as set forth herein, either party may apply to the Superior Court, Chancery Division, to settle and resolve said dispute in such fashion as will tend to accomplish the purposes of the HMFA Law.
- 11. This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same agreement. It shall not be necessary in making proof of this Agreement to produce or account for more than a sufficient number of counterparts to evidence the execution of this Agreement by each party hereto.

RECOGNITION AGREEMENT

(Financial Agreement)

This RECOGNITION AGREEMENT ("Agreement") dated as of September ____, 2021, is made by THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN, a municipal corporation in the County of Hudson and the State of New Jersey, having its offices at 4233 Kennedy Boulevard, North Bergen, New Jersey 07047 ("Municipality"), for the benefit of TD BANK, N.A., a national banking association, having an address at 1100 Lake Street, Ramsey, New Jersey 07446 (together with its successors and assigns, "Mortgagee").

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, NORTH BERGEN RENAISSANCE SUPPORTIVE HOUSING, LP, a New Jersey limited partnership (the "Mortgagor") is the leasehold owner of that certain parcel of improved real property described in <u>Schedule A</u> attached hereto and made a part hereof (the "Land");

WHEREAS, Mortgagee has made a construction loan to the Mortgagor in the principal amount of \$16,500,000.00 (the "Loan" or the "Mortgage Amount") in connection with a 61-unit multifamily project located on the Land in the Township of North Bergen, Hudson County, State of New Jersey and known as [North Bergen Supportive Housing];

WHEREAS, the Loan is evidenced by that certain Mortgage Loan Note dated as of July 28, 2021, effective as of August 25, 2021 made by Mortgagor in favor of Mortgagee in the maximum principal amount of \$16,500,000.00 (the "Note"); and

WHEREAS, the Note is secured by that certain Construction Loan Leasehold Mortgage and Security Agreement dated as of July 28, 2021, effective as of August 25, 2021 hereof made by Mortgagor in favor of Mortgagee (the "Mortgage"); and

WHEREAS, Mortgagor and Municipality have entered into that certain Agreement for Payment in Lieu of Taxes dated July 17, 2019 (together with all amendments thereto and modifications, renewals, extensions and replacements thereof, the "Financial Agreement"); and

NOW, THEREFORE, for Ten and No/100 Dollars (\$10.00), and as an inducement for the Mortgagee's making of the Loan to Mortgagor, and in consideration of the benefits to be received and expected to be received by Municipality and by Mortgagor in connection therewith, the parties hereto covenant, agree, represent and warrant as follows:

1. <u>Municipality's Representations, Warranties and Covenants Regarding</u>
<u>the Redevelopment Agreement</u>. Municipality hereby represents, warrants and covenants to Mortgagee that, as of the date hereof:

- (a) Attached hereto as <u>Exhibit B</u> is a true, correct and complete copy of the Financial Agreement, including all exhibits and other attachments thereto and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof, and the Financial Agreement is in full force and effect and has not been cancelled, modified, supplemented, amended, extended, renewed or terminated;
- (b) To the best of Municipality's knowledge, there exists no default, breach or violation by either party under the Financial Agreement;
- (c) Municipality hereby consents to the Mortgage and to the perfection of the lien created thereunder upon Mortgagor's interest in and to the Property;
- (d) Municipality acknowledges that Mortgagee is the mortgagee providing financing on the Property and that notices as provided for in the Financial Agreement which are to be sent to the Mortgagor shall also be sent to Mortgagee as follows:

Right to Foreclose. Upon the occurrence and continuance of an Event of Default (following the expiration of all applicable notice and cure periods) by Mortgagor under and as defined in the Mortgage, Mortgagee shall, subject to the terms of the Mortgage, have the right, (a) to foreclose upon, or accept a deed in lieu of foreclosure of, Mortgagor's leasehold right, title and interest in and to the Property created thereby and thereunder, and any other real or personal property securing the Mortgage, and to exercise any other right or remedy which is available pursuant to the Mortgage or the other Loan Documents (as defined in the Mortgage), or at law or in equity, and (b) thereafter, to sell, transfer and assign the Property and any other real or personal property securing the Mortgage to any person or entity (a "Purchaser") in accordance with the terms of the Financial Agreement. The Municipality's agrees to consent to the Purchaser as aforesaid as provided in and subject to the terms of Section 6 of the Financial Agreement. It is understood that such Purchaser, in order to get the benefits under the Financial Agreement must qualify for such benefits as provided under the New Jersey Long Term Tax Exemption Law, including any successor statutes, as same may be

modified. Municipality confirms that if Mortgagee or a Purchaser becomes the owner of the Property as aforesaid, then Mortgagee or such Purchaser shall succeed to all of Mortgagor's rights and benefits under the Financial Agreement provided that Mortgagee or such Purchaser assumes the obligations of Mortgagor under the Financial Agreement.

3. <u>Forbearance</u>. If Mortgagee decides to foreclose upon Mortgagor's right, title and interest in and to the Property pursuant to and subject to the terms of the Mortgage, Municipality agrees to forbear from exercising any right to terminate the Financial Agreement in order to permit Mortgagee to complete the foreclosure provided that Mortgagee diligently pursues such foreclosure and provided that Mortgagee cures any defaults that are reasonably susceptible to cure by Mortgagee.

4. Miscellaneous.

- (a) Governing Law. This Agreement and the rights and obligations of the parties hereunder shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey, without giving effect to its internal principles of conflicts of law. Municipality hereby irrevocably submits to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of any state or federal court in New Jersey over any action, suit or proceeding arising out of or relating to this Agreement.
- (b) <u>Successors and Assigns</u>. This Agreement, and the information contained herein, shall be binding on, and enforceable by and against, Municipality and Municipality's successors and assigns, and this Agreement, and the information contained herein, shall inure to the benefit of, and be enforceable by Mortgagee and/or Bondholder Representative and its successors and assigns.
- (c) THE PARTIES HERETO, EACH HEREBY AGREE NOT TO ELECT A TRIAL BY JURY OF ANY ISSUE TRIABLE OF RIGHT BY JURY, AND WAIVE ANY RIGHT TO TRIAL BY JURY FULLY TO THE EXTENT THAT ANY SUCH RIGHT SHALL NOW OR HEREAFTER EXIST WITH REGARD TO THIS AGREEMENT, OR ANY CLAIM, COUNTERCLAIM OR OTHER ACTION ARISING IN CONNECTION HEREWITH. THIS WAIVER OF RIGHT TO TRIAL BY JURY IS GIVEN KNOWINGLY AND VOLUNTARILY BY THE PARTIES HERETO AND IS INTENDED TO ENCOMPASS INDIVIDUALLY EACH INSTANCE AND EACH ISSUE AS TO WHICH THE RIGHT TO A TRIAL BY JURY WOULD OTHERWISE ACCRUE. THE PARTIES HERETO ARE EACH HEREBY AUTHORIZED TO FILE A COPY OF THIS PARAGRAPH IN ANY PROCEEDING AS CONCLUSIVE EVIDENCE OF THIS WAIVER.

AGREEMENT FOR PAYMENT IN LIEU OF TAXES

North Bergen Supportive Housing, HMFA #(s)_____

THIS AGREEMENT, made this day of JULY 2019, between North Bergen Renaissance Supportive Housing, LP, a limited partnership, of the State of New Jersey, having its principal office at One Parker Plaza. Fort Lee, New Jersey 07024 (hereinafter the "Sponsor") and the Township of North Bergen, a municipal corporation in the County of Hudson and State of New Jersey (hereinafter the "Municipality").

WITNESSETH

In consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained and for other good and valuable consideration, it is mutually covenanted and agreed as follows:

- 1. This Agreement is made pursuant to the authority contained in Section 37 of the New Jersey Housing and Mortgage Finance Agency Law of 1983 (N.J.S.A. 55: 14K-1 et seq.) (hereinafter "HMFA Law") and a Resolution of the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen dated ______, 2019, (the "Resolution") and with the approval of the New Jersey Housing and Mortgage Finance Agency (hereinafter the "Agency"), as required by N.J.S.A. 55:14K-37.
- 2. The Project is or will be situated on that parcel of land designated as Block 235, Lot 22 as shown on the Official Assessment Map of the Township of North Bergen, and more commonly referred to as 6725 Columbia Avenue, North Bergen, Hudson County, New Jersey.
- As of the date the Sponsor executes a first mortgage upon the Project in favor of the Agency (hereinafter referred to as the "Agency Mortgage"), the land and improvements comprising the Project shall be exempt from real property taxes, provided that the Sponsor shall make payments in lieu of taxes to the Municipality as provided hereinafter. The exemption of the Project from real property taxation and the sponsor's obligation to make payments in lieu of taxes shall not extend beyond the date on which the Agency Mortgage is paid in full, which, according to the HMFA Law, may not exceed fifty (50) years.
- 4. (a) For projects receiving construction and permanent financing from the Agency, the Sponsor shall make payment to the Municipality of an annual service charge in lieu of taxes in such amount as follows:

- (1) From the date of the execution of the Agency Mortgage until the date of substantial completion of the Project, the Sponsor shall make payment to the municipality in an amount equal to the amount of taxes due on the property for the year preceding the recording of the Agency Mortgage. As used herein, "Substantial Completion" means the date upon which the Municipality issues the Certificate of Occupancy for all units in the Project.
- (2) From the date of Substantial Completion of the Project and for the remaining term of the NJHMFA Mortgage, the Sponsor shall make payment to the Municipality in an amount equal to 6.28 percent of Project Revenues.
- (b) For Projects receiving permanent financing only from the Agency, the Sponsor shall make payment to the Municipality in an amount equal to 6.28 percent of Project Revenues from the date of the Agency Mortgage and for the remaining term of the Agency Mortgage.
- (c) As used herein, "Project Revenues" means the total annual gross rental or carrying charge and other income of the Sponsor from the Project less the costs of utilities furnished by the Project, which shall include the costs of gas, electricity, heating fuel, water supplied, and sewage charges, and less vacancies if any. Project Revenues shall not include any rental subsidy contributions received from any federal or state program.
- (d) The amount of payment in lieu of taxes to be paid pursuant to paragraphs (a) or (b) and (c) above is calculated in Exhibit "A" attached hereto. It is expressly understood and agreed that the revenue projections provided to the Municipality as set forth in Exhibit "A" and as part of the Sponsor's application for an agreement for payments in lieu of taxes are estimates only. The actual payments in lieu of taxes to be paid by the Sponsor shall be determined pursuant to Section 5 below.
- 5. (a) Payments by the Sponsor shall be made on a quarterly basis in accordance with bills issued by the Tax Collector of the Municipality in the same manner and on the same dates as real estate taxes are paid to the Municipality and shall be based upon Project Revenues of the previous quarter. No later than three (3) months following the end of the first fiscal year of operation after (i) the date of Substantial Completion (for projects receiving construction and permanent financing) or (ii) the date of the Agency Mortgage (for projects receiving permanent financing only) and each year thereafter that this Agreement remains in effect, the Sponsor shall submit to the Municipality a certified, audited financial statement of the operation of the Project (the "Audit"), setting forth the Project Revenues and the total payments in lieu of taxes due to the Municipality calculated at 6.28 percent of Project Revenues as set forth in the Audit (the "Audit Amount"). The Sponsor simultaneously shall pay the difference, if any, between (i) the Audit Amount and (ii) payments made by the Sponsor to the Municipality for the preceding fiscal year. The Municipality may accept any such payment without prejudice to its right to challenge the amount due. In the event that the payments made by the Sponsor for any fiscal year shall exceed the Audit Amount for such

fiscal year, the Municipality shall credit the amount of such excess to the account of the Sponsor.

- (b) All payments pursuant to this Agreement shall be in lieu of taxes and the Municipality shall have all the rights and remedies of tax enforcement granted to Municipalities by law just as if said payments constituted regular tax obligations on real property within the Municipality. If, however, the Municipality disputes the total amount of the annual payment in lieu of taxes due it, based upon the Audit, it may apply to the Superior Court, Chancery Division for an accounting of the service charge due the Municipality, in accordance with this Agreement and HMFA Law. Any such action must be commenced within one year of the receipt of the Audit by the Municipality.
- (c) In the event of any delinquency in the aforesaid payments, the Municipality shall give notice to the Sponsor and NJHMFA in the manner set forth in 9(a) below, prior to any legal action being taken.
- 6. The tax exemption provided herein shall apply only so long as the Sponsor or its successors and assigns and the Project remain subject to the provisions of the HMFA Law and Regulations made thereunder and the supervision of the Agency, but in no event longer than the term of the Agency Mortgage. In the event of (a) a sale, transfer or conveyance of the Project by the Sponsor or (b) a change in the organizational structure of the Sponsor, this Agreement shall be assigned to the Sponsor's successor and shall continue in full force and effect so long as the successor entity qualifies under the HMFA Law or any other state law applicable at the time of the assignment of this Agreement and is obligated under the Agency Mortgage.

Upon the payment in full of the Agency Mortgage, the Sponsor or its successor, as applicable, shall give notice to the Municipality within ten (10) business days of the date the Agency Mortgage is paid.

- 7. Upon any termination of such tax exemption, whether by affirmative action of the Sponsor, its successors and assigns, or by virtue of the provisions of the HMFA Law, or any other applicable state law, the Project shall be taxed as omitted property in accordance with the law.
- 8. The Sponsor, its successors and assigns shall, upon request, permit inspection of property, equipment, buildings and other facilities of the Project and also documents and papers by representatives duly authorized by the Municipality. Any such inspection, examination or audit shall be made during reasonable hours of the business day, in the presence of an officer or agent of the Sponsor or its successors and assigns.
- 9. Any notice or communication sent by either party to the other hereunder shall be sent by certified mail, return receipt requested, addressed as follows:
- (a) When sent by the Municipality to the Sponsor, it shall be addressed to Joseph Alpert, One Parker Plaza, Fort Lee, New Jersey 07024 or to such other address as the Sponsor may hereafter designate in writing and a copy of said notice or communication by the Municipality to the Sponsor shall be sent by the Municipality to

the New Jersey Housing and Mortgage Finance Agency, 637 South Clinton Avenue, P.O. Box 18550, Trenton, New Jersey 08650-2085.

- (b) When sent by the Sponsor to the Municipality, it shall be addressed to the Office of the Township Administrator. Township of North Bergen, 4233 Kennedy Boulevard, North Bergen, New Jersey 07047 or to such other address as the Municipality may designate in writing; and a copy of sald notice or communication by the Sponsor to the Municipality shall be sent by the Sponsor to the New Jersey Housing and Mortgage Finance Agency, 637 South Clinton Avenue, P.O. Box 18550, Trenton, New Jersey 08650-2085.
- 10. In the event of a breach of this Agreement by either of the parties hereto or a dispute arising between the parties in reference to the terms and provisions as set forth herein, either party may apply to the Superior Court, Chancery Division, to settle and resolve said dispute in such fashion as will tend to accomplish the purposes of the HMFA Law.
- 11. This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same agreement. It shall not be necessary in making proof of this Agreement to produce or account for more than a sufficient number of counterparts to evidence the execution of this Agreement by each party hereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the redevelopment area determination shall authorize the Township of North Bergen to use all those powers provided by the legislature for use in a redevelopment area, excluding the power of eminent domain ("Non-Condemnation Redevelopment Area").

TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN HUDSON COUNTY

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A TRAP, NEUTER, RETURN (TNR) PROGRAM FOR FERAL CATS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN, as follows:

Section I. <u>Background & Purposes</u>

The Township of North Bergen (the "Township") supports humane, lawful, and effective strategies for managing feral cat populations, which not only provide life-saving options for cats that might otherwise be euthanized when admitted to a shelter, but can also stabilize, and even reduce over time, the population of feral cat colonies. The Township recognizes that it has feral cat colonies within its boundaries, and, therefore, seeks to enact regulations to assist in managing and protecting these colonies while at the same time balancing the needs of Township residents to be free from any nuisance that feral cat colonies may cause. The purpose of this Ordinance is to create a Trap-Neuter-Return ("TNR") Program within the Township for feral cat populations. The Township, like many other communities throughout the State of New Jersey, has an obligation to effectively and humanely control the feral cat populations within its borders and believes it is in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Township to institute a TNR Program.

Section II. <u>Definitions</u>

Solely for the purposes of this Ordinance, the following terms shall have the following meaning, unless the context clearly dictates otherwise:

Animal Control Officer shall mean the person or entity employed by or contracting with the Township who provides animal control services for the Township, which may include, without limitation, (1) the care of injured animals, trapped animals, sick animals, animals whose lives are endangered or animals that are creating a danger to humans, (2) touring the streets of the Township on a regular basis for licensed and unlicensed dogs running at large for the purpose of issuing summonses to the owners thereof where possible and appropriate, (3) picking up and removing all deceased animals on any of the roadways in the Township, (4) delivering unwanted animals to a licensed shelter, (5) impounding any stray or licensed dog or cat running at large on the streets of the Township, and (6) the handling of all domestic animals.

Caregiver shall mean a volunteer, uncompensated person at least twenty-one (21) years of age who is registered with the Township to facilitate the TNR Program with the Township in accordance with this Ordinance and any rules and regulations that may be established by the Health Officer, and who provides food, water or shelter to or otherwise cares for a feral cat(s). A Caregiver shall not be deemed an employee of the Township.

Domesticated cat shall mean a cat that is socialized to humans and is appropriate as a companion for humans.

Ear tipping shall mean a straight-line cutting of the tip of the left ear of a cat by a licensed veterinarian while the cat is anesthetized.

Feed shall mean to give, place, expose, deposit, distribute or scatter any edible material.

Feral cat shall mean a cat which is completely or substantially un-socialized to humans. The usual and consistent temperament of a feral cat is extreme fear and resistance to contact with humans. Feral cats are either born in the wild, the offspring of tame or feral cats and not socialized, or formerly tame cats which have been abandoned and have reverted to an untamed state.

Feral cat colony shall mean an individual feral cat or a group of cats which congregate together outside as a unit. Any non-feral cats which congregate with a multiple-cat colony shall be deemed part of it.

Health Investigator shall mean an investigator employed by the Township within the Township Health Department who is authorized to investigate violations of Township ordinances providing for the health, safety, and welfare of the Township residents.

Health Officer shall mean the Township Health Director.

Humane Law Enforcement Officer shall mean that person designated by the Director of Public Safety or Chief of Police as the Township Humane Law Enforcement Officer, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 4:22-14.1, et seq., and who shall be responsible for animal welfare within the jurisdiction of the Township, and who shall be authorized to investigate and sign complaints, arrest violators, and otherwise act as an officer for detection, apprehension, and arrest of offenders against the animal welfare and animal cruelty laws of the State and ordinances of the Township.

Nuisance shall mean a cat or cats disturbing the peace by habitually or continually howling, crying or screaming, or their unreasonable destruction, desecration or soiling of property against the wishes of the owner of the property.

Stray cat shall mean a cat which is regularly off the property of its owner, is not under the physical control and restraint of its owner and is not regularly provided with food by its owner.

Suitable shelter shall mean a shelter that provides protection from rain, sun, and other elements that is adequate to protect the health of the cat.

Tame cat shall mean a cat which is socialized to humans and is appropriate as a companion for humans.

TNR shall mean trap, neuter, and return.

TNR Committee shall mean any group of individuals or entity appointed by the Health Officer, that will perform the duties and responsibilities as established in this Ordinance.

TNR Program shall mean a program pursuant to which feral and stray cats are trapped, neutered or spayed, vaccinated against rabies, ear tipped, and returned to the location where they congregate.

Section III. Health Officer Oversight of TNR Program

A. The Health Officer shall oversee and coordinate all aspects of the TNR Program. The Health Officer shall have the power to delegate any functions of the TNR Program as she determines necessary, to any of the following:

- 1. The Township's Animal Control Officer;
- 2. Health Department personnel and Health Investigators; and
- 3. The Township Humane Law Enforcement Officer.
- B. In delegating to or coordinating with other employees or contractors, the Health Officer shall consult with Department Directors overseeing such employees and contractors, as well as the Township Administrator.
- C. The Health Officer shall have the power to take any actions as may be required to implement the purposes of this Ordinance, including, but not limited to the following:
 - 1. The promulgation of any rules and regulations as may be required or expedient to carry out the purposes of this Ordinance, including, without limitation:
 - a. Training for Caregivers;
 - b. Training of TNR Committee members;
 - c. Required procedures for and the conduct of feral cat colonies, Caregivers, and TNR Committees;
 - d. Complaint procedures regarding feral cat colonies, Caregivers and TNR Committees;
 - e. Records creation and maintenance requirements regarding the registration, size, and location of the feral cat colonies as well as the vaccination and spay/neuter records of the cats in the colonies; and
 - f. Procedures for the revocation of feral cat colony, Caregiver and TNR Committee approved status, which procedures may be perfunctory.
 - 2. The promulgation of any applications that may be necessary to implement the provisions of this Ordinance; and
 - 3. The creation of any TNR Committees that may be warranted under this Ordinance, and assign any Caregiver responsibilities to the TNR Committee.
- D. The Health Officer, in conjunction with the Township Purchasing Department and in accordance with any budgetary limitations, may arrange for the following:
 - 1. The establishment of approved veterinarians authorized to provide services required pursuant to this Ordinance;
 - 2. Arrange for the compensation of veterinarians providing services under this Ordinance; and
 - 3. Arrange for the funding and reimbursement of Caregivers who expend money in the furtherance of the purposes of this Ordinance.

Section IV. Feral Cat Colonies Trial Period

A. Feral cat colonies shall be permitted on a trial basis for one (1) year from the effective date of this Ordinance. The Health Officer, in consultation with the Township Administrator, shall determine whether to continue the program thereafter. The Health Officer's determination shall be sent by e-mail and regular mail to any Caregiver registered/permitted under this Ordinance.

B. In the event the permitting of feral cat colonies is discontinued, Caregivers shall cease and desist feeding feral cats, and shall follow any directives of the Health Officer in reducing and discontinuing the maintenance of feral cat colony(ies) pursuant to this Ordinance.

Section V. Feral Cat Colony Requirements

- A. Feral cat colonies may lawfully exist, provided they meet the requirements in this Ordinance and any rules and regulations promulgated by the Health Officer, including the following:
 - 1. The maximum number of cats per feral cat colony is not to exceed six (6) cats;
 - 2. A Caregiver must be responsible for any feral cat colony;
 - 3. The Caregiver for the feral cat colony, the feral cat colony itself, and any TNR Committee associated with feral cat colony shall all be registered with and approved by the Health Officer;
 - 4. The Caregiver, feral cat colony and any associated TNR Committee must comply with the requirements in this Ordinance and any rules and regulations promulgated by the Health Officer.
- B. The Health Officer has the right to limit the number of feral cat colonies as she determines.

Section VI. Feral Cat Caregiver Responsibilities

- A. It shall be the duty of feral cat Caregivers to:
 - 1. Register the feral cat colony with the Township and obtain Township approval;
 - 2. Take steps to vaccinate the feral cat colony population for rabies, update the required vaccination protocols whenever possible, and take steps to get all cats in the colony population spayed/neutered by a licensed veterinarian;
 - 3. Regularly observe the feral cat colony for illnesses and unusual behavior;
 - 4. Obtain proper medical attention for any colony cat which appears to require it;
 - 5. Set up consistent and monitored feeding schedules, which shall be limited to daylight hours, and where all remaining food must be removed daily;
 - 6. Provide water and, if feasible, provide suitable shelter for feral colony cats;
 - 7. Compile and maintain records of the feral cat colony, including the following:
 - a. The registration and approval of the colony;
 - b. The registration and approval of the Caregiver and any associated TNR Committee;
 - c. Digital photos of each cat in the colony;
 - d. Vaccination, spayed/neutering and ear tipping;
 - e. Illnesses or unusual behavior noticed in any colony cats;
 - f. Veterinary services provided;
 - g. The location of the colony, and any owner approval/non approval records as per this section; and
 - h. The number and gender of cat in the colony;

- 8. Obtain the written approval of the owner of any property on which the feral cat colony is located or the written approval of the owner of any property over which the Caregiver requires access so as to provide colony care. The written approval shall be filed with the Health Officer by the Caregiver. If the Caregiver is unable to obtain the written approval because either the access property or the property on which the colony is located is abandoned, unused or unoccupied, the Caregiver shall send a request for approval to the owner of the property as listed on the current tax rolls by certified mail, return receipt requested. If no response is forthcoming for 10 days, the Caregiver shall send a second request by certified mail, return receipt requested. If no response is forthcoming after a second 10-day period, the Caregiver may file a certification with the Health Officer setting forth the two failed attempts and attaching the two certified mail receipts after which approval shall be presumed until the property owner's written response is obtained;
- 9. Take steps, in the event that kittens are born to a colony cat, to remove the kittens from the colony after they have been weaned, and place the kittens in homes, foster homes, or with animal shelters, rescue organizations or veterinary offices for the purpose of subsequent permanent placement;
- 10. Report semiannually in writing to the Health Officer the status of the colony, the total number of cats in the colony, including data on the number and gender of all cats in the colony, the number of cats who died or otherwise ceased being a part of the colony during the prior six-month period, the number of kittens born to colony cats and their disposition, the number of cats and kittens spayed and neutered and the number of cats and kittens placed in permanent homes as companion cats;
- 11. Undergo any training developed under this Ordinance for themselves and their responsible substitutes in the proper management of a feral cat colony;
- 12. "Ear tip" all colony cats with a single cut preferably on the left ear; and
- 13. Resolve any complaints over the conduct of a colony or of cats within a colony.

Section VII. Cat Colony Caregivers Registration

- A. Any person seeking to become a Caregiver or establish a TNR Committee shall first register and be approved by the Township Health Department, which process shall be at no cost to the applicants.
- B. Applications for registration and approval shall include the following:
 - 1. Name, address, phone number, and e-mail;
 - 2. Location of colony, number of cats in colony, description of cats in colony, with photos;
 - 3. Caregiver's and, if applicable, TNR Committee member's background insofar as experience with cats, cat colonies, or other animal care experience;
 - 4. Caregiver's and, if applicable, TNR Committee's plan for control of colony, minimizing the nuisances that arise from cat colonies, and reducing the proliferation of the colony; and
 - 5. Any other information the Health Officer determines to necessary in evaluating the application.

Section VIII. Exemptions from Restrictive Ordinances

- A. A registered Caregiver shall not be considered an owner of the colony cats or be subject to regulations governing ownership or control of the colony cats, except as specified in this Ordinance.
- B. Township Ordinances providing for cat licensing or the control and maintenance of cats shall not apply to feral cat colonies approved and managed pursuant to the TNR Program or to any person or organization that is providing care for a feral cat colony and is taking steps to trap and sterilize the animals.

Section IX. Nuisance Complaints

The requirements of this Ordinance notwithstanding, Health Department Investigators, or the Animal Control Officer (if authorized by the Health Officer), may investigate any nuisance complaint. If such person determines that an ear-tipped feral colony cat is causing a nuisance as defined by this Ordinance, the Health Investigator or Animal Control Officer shall contact the Caregiver and allow the Caregiver 10 days to resolve the complaint or remove the cat before the Health Investigator or Animal Control Officer takes further action. The Caregiver must begin to diligently pursue nuisance abatement procedures immediately after being notified of a nuisance and must take all reasonable steps to resolve the nuisance in as short a time period as possible, not to exceed 10 days. If the Caregiver fails to resolve the nuisance or remove the cat within the 10 days, the Health Investigator or Animal Control Officer may remove and relocate the cat. If a Health Investigator or Animal Control Officer reasonably determines that a cat is injured or poses a significant threat to public health, then such person may reduce the time that the Caregiver has to resolve the complaint, as necessary to protect the cat and public health, before taking further action. In the case of an emergency, the Animal Control Officer may remove the cat, but within 24 hours the Township must provide the Caregiver with notice of the cat's whereabouts and allow the Caregiver an opportunity to retrieve the cat for treatment, return, or relocation.

Section X. Enforcement and Right to Seize

A. This Ordinance shall be enforced by the Health Officer and Health Department Investigators. Notwithstanding any other rights available to the Township by statute, code, regulation, and/or common law, the Township shall maintain the following rights:

- 1. The right to seize or remove from a feral cat colony cats which have not been vaccinated against rabies and who are demonstrating signs of disease;
- 2. The right to seize or remove from a feral cat colony a cat which is creating a nuisance after the Caregiver has been given 10 days to resolve the complaint or remove and relocate the cat and has failed to do so;
- 3. The right to seize or remove a colony of cats when the Caregiver regularly fails to comply with the requirements of this Ordinance, and a replacement Caregiver for the feral cat colony has not been designated within 10 days of the Township's notice to the Caregiver of his or her failure to comply with this Ordinance;
- 4. The right to replace or remove a Caregiver who fails to comply with the responsibilities and requirements of this Ordinance after reasonable notice is provided to the Caregiver of noncompliance; and
- 5. The right to withdraw approvals issued to Caregivers, feral cat colonies and TNR Committees.

Section XI. Penalties

Any individual, corporation or other entity violating any provision of this ordinance shall, for each such offense and upon conviction thereof, be subject to a minimum penalty of a fine of \$50 and a maximum fine not exceeding \$500. Each day any violation of this Ordinance shall continue shall constitute a separate offense. Any person who is convicted of violating this Ordinance within one year of the date of a previous violation of this same Ordinance and who was fined for the previous violation, shall be sentenced by a court to an additional fine as a repeat offender. The additional fine imposed by the court upon a person for a repeated offense shall not be less than the minimum or exceed the maximum fine fixed for a violation of this Ordinance, but shall be calculated separately from the fine imposed for the violation of this Ordinance.

Section XII. Severability

If any part or parts of this Ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section XIII. Repealer

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistency thereof.

Section XIV. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days from the time of its final passage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen that:

Section 1: One restricted handicapped parking space be and hereby is established in front of the residence of Jeremy M. Parra Vega of 8612 Liberty Avenue, Denise Bartone-Pollack of 6214 Newkirk Avenue, Jose A. Martinez of 6509 Bergenwood Avenue, David A. Fuentes of 6604 Grand Avenue, William Palacios of 1460 - 71st Street, and Harshabala D. Desai of 1316 - 7th Street, North Bergen, N.J. 07047.

Section 2: The aforesaid space shall be used only by a motor vehicle displaying a permit issued by the North Bergen Police Department identifying the location of said handicapped parking space and the specific motor vehicle entitled to use same.

Section 3: The North Bergen Department of Public Works shall establish a restricted parking zone at the above location and shall erect a sign with the legend "Handicapped Parking for Resident Vehicle License Plate Number "N 2 1 M R N" for Jeremy M. WHEREAS, by Ordinance 272-15, adopted November 24, 2015, the Township of North Bergen updated and re-established its construction fee schedule; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to update certain fees concerning heating, ventilation, air conditioning, and refrigeration ("HVACR") work and road openings, and there is a need to establish an escrow deposit for payment of engineering and other professional services where review of an application requires such review.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN that:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance 272-15, as amended, be and it is hereby further amended to include the following section:

Section 3. Ordinance 272-15, as amended, be and it is hereby further amended to include the following section:

Escrow for Professional Services.

For any permit application filed with the Township Building Department, where the Director of Community Improvement, Construction Code Official, or Zoning Official

determines that the application requires review by an outside consultant, such as a professional engineer or architect, the Township may require that the applicant submit a deposit to be held in escrow by the Township for payment of the outside consultants' reasonable fees. Where the total cost of the proposed project is less than \$200,000, the initial escrow deposit shall be \$3,000. For projects where the cost is \$200,000 or greater, the initial escrow deposit shall be \$5,000.

The Township may require additional escrow deposits when available escrow funds on deposit for the particular project with the Township fall below \$1,000. The applicant shall be responsible for all outside consultant reasonable fees.

The failure to provide required escrow deposits shall be grounds for the Building Department to revoke permits or issue a stop work orders.

The outside consultants' reasonable fees under this Ordinance shall be substantially the same as those professional charges applicants for development, review and preparation of documents or inspection of improvements pay for the Township's outside consultants under the Municipal Land Use Law.

Section 4. If any article, section, sub-section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason deemed to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistency thereof.
