RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING AND ACCEPTING ACCREDITATION OF THE NORTH BERGEN POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM THE NEW JERSEY STATE ASSOCIATION OF CHIEFS OF POLICE

WHEREAS, the New Jersey State Association of Chiefs of Police ("NJSACOP") has pursued the concept and development of a voluntary statewide law enforcement accreditation program for New Jersey, which has resulted in the formation of the NJSACOP Law Enforcement Accreditation Commission (the "Commission"), consisting of commissioners with the overall responsibility of adoption of program standards, as well as review of all assessment reports and approval of all recommendations for the granting of accredited status of applicant law enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, Commission accreditation is a method of assisting law enforcement agencies to calculate and improve their overall performance and advance their professional growth, and the foundation of accreditation lies in the adoption of standards containing a clear statement of professional objectives and is based on best practices; and

WHEREAS, comprehensive and effective law enforcement leadership is directly influenced through the development and adoption of professionally-based policies and procedures; and

WHEREAS, law enforcement agencies participating in the Commission accreditation process conduct a thorough self-analysis to determine how existing operations can be adapted to meet the foregoing standards and objectives; and

WHEREAS, when the procedures are in place, a team of trained, independent assessors verifies that the applicable standards have been successfully implemented; and

WHEREAS, Commission accreditation acknowledges the implementation of policies and procedures that are conceptually sound and operationally effective reflecting a commitment to advancement of the law enforcement profession; and

WHEREAS, Commission accredited status represents a significant professional achievement; and

WHEREAS, the attitudes, training, and actions of the North Bergen Police Department reflect their dedication to compliance with the standards contained in the accreditation program; and

WHEREAS, after its extensive review, the Commission has determined that the North Bergen Police Department should be accredited, and wishes to present the Township with an Accreditation Certificate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN that:

WHEREAS, these recreation programs have operated in a hybrid fashion, with the Township providing facilities, personnel and assisting with financial contributions to the programs, and with the separate programs, at times, designating officers of the programs and overseeing all financial components of the programs; and

WHEREAS, there has been no policy or defined structure for the recreation programs; and

WHEREAS, because of the hybrid nature of the programs, and because the Township funds the programs, in part, there is a need for stronger oversight and consistency in the operation of the programs; and

WHEREAS, it will serve the best interests of the participants in the recreation programs, and the citizens of North Bergen, if the Township controls all aspects of the recreation programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN that:

- 1. The aforesaid recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.
- 2. The Township will assume all financial responsibility of all recreation programs. Said financial control will include, but not be limited to maintaining all accounts and budgets, and handling all purchasing for the programs.
- 3. The Township will provide all facilities, courts, buildings, fields, uniforms, equipment, employees & transportation for the programs.
- 4. The Township will collect registration fees, voluntary fundraising contributions, and other revenue items and maintain and administer the funds in a dedicated recreational trust fund in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:48-2.56.

- 5. The Commissioner of Parks and Public Property shall have broad power to effectuate the Township's responsibilities pursuant to Sections 2 through 4, consistent with the powers delegated to him/her under the Walsh Act, N.J.S.A. 40:70-1, et seq., and as delegated by the Board of Commissioners. Said powers shall include, but not be limited to, the following:
 - a. To determine the structure and scope of the recreation department;
 - b. To determine which programs to offer, and to set the criteria and qualifications therefore.

 - d. To set registration and other fees for the programs.
 - e. To authorize fundraising activities.
 - f. To authorize travel to competitions or other activities for the programs.
 - g. To authorize volunteer workers and determine their responsibilities.
 - h. To authorize advisory committees and representatives for any programs.
 - i. To determine registration dates and deadlines.
 - j. To authorize the Town of Guttenberg's children to participate in the Township's programs.
 - k. To implement any policies, procedures or guidelines relative to any of the foregoing.
- 6. Nothing herein shall be interpreted to restrict or nullify any powers heretofore granted to the Commissioner of Parks and Public Property, whether by law, ordinance, or resolution.
- 7. The Township will assume the controls set forth in this Resolution, effective January 1, 2017, and the Commissioner of Parks and Public Property, Deputy Director of Parks and Public Property, Township Administrator, Chief Financial Officer, Purchasing Agent, Treasurer, Township Attorney, and any other necessary official, officer or employee of the Township be and they are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents and to take any and all actions necessary to complete and realize the intent and purpose of this Resolution.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONCESSION PROCUREMENT FOR VARIOUS FOOD AND BEVERAGE STANDS LOCATED WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN

WHEREAS, the Township of North Bergen wishes to make available food, snacks and beverages at various Township recreation concession stands during certain scheduled recreation events in 2017; and

WHEREAS, the locations of the concession stands are listed in Schedule "A" attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, a contract for the provision of food, snacks and beverages may be awarded as a concession pursuant to <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 5:34-9.4; and

WHEREAS, prior to undertaking a concession procurement, the Board of Commissioners is required to adopt a resolution addressing various items set forth in N.J.A.C. 5:34-9.4(d)(2); and

WHEREAS, said items and the explanation for each follow:

- i. A description of the public need to award a concession: The need to award the concession arises out of the Township's desire to make food, snacks and beverages available at various sports fields and centers within the Township.
- ii. The concession to be awarded: The concession will be making available for sale food, snacks and beverages, and in exchange for the right to provide such service, the Township will require quotes as to the amount to be paid to the Township.
- iii. The considerations, including the benefits and any risks the governing body took into account in reaching the decision to award a concession: The benefits to the Township citizens will be having food and beverages available at sporting and other recreation events. The taxpayers will benefit because the Township will avoid significant costs and will likely receive payment from the selected vendor for the right to provide the services. The risks are not significant and will be controlled by requiring insurance and indemnification language in the contract with the vendor.
- iv. An estimate of the total value of the concession: The Township presently does not have data for this determination, but has no basis to believe that the total value exceeds \$40,000. The contract awarded will require the vendor to submit financial data so the Township may make a non-arbitrary determination as to value for future contracts.

- v. If any, an estimate of any revenue or services to be received by the contracting unit: The Township anticipates receiving approximately \$15,000.
- vi. The basis of award of the concession is based upon the most advantageous price and other factors or the lowest responsible bidder: The concession contract will be awarded based upon the most advantageous price and other factors, which will include quality of products and services, and references.
- vii. An estimate of any costs to be incurred by the contracting unit as part of the concession: The Township will incur some minimal cost in cleaning and maintaining the building(s) in which the vendor(s) operates. Said costs are already covered within the Townships fixed labor costs. The Township will also provide utilities for the vendor's operations on site.
- viii. Any services, facilities, or endorsement to be provided by the contracting unit: See prior item.
- ix. The method to be used to procure the concession: An informal quotation process will be used pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:34-9.4(g)(1); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:34-9.4(d)(1), the Township has received a legal opinion from the Township attorney that a concession procurement may be used for the services set forth herein.

Section 3: The North Bergen Department of Public Works shall establish a restricted parking zone at the above location and shall erect a sign with the legend "Handicapped Parking for Resident Vehicle License Plate Number "Y Z D 8 8 N" for Arthur A. Cavanagh, "W H M 6 9 A" for Blanca A. Santamaria, "U 4 8 D S A" for Tushar D. Shah and "1 4 2 9 H C" for Luis R. Tobar, and this Ordinance Number.

Section 4: This ordinance shall remain in effect for two (2) years ending December 31st of the second year from its effective date at which point it will expire and be of no further force or effect unless it is renewed for a further two (2) year period by formal resolution of the Board of Commissioners in accordance with Ordinance Nos. 1115-07 and 40-10.

Section 5: Any person who commits a violation of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of at least \$300.00 and up to 90 days of Community Service on such terms and in such form as the Municipal Court Judge deems appropriate or any combination thereof. A separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which the violation continues.

Section 6: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistency thereof.

Section 7: If any part or parts of this ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 8: This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication as required by law.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SPECIAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER POSITION AND COMPENSATION IN THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN as follows:

Section 1. Background and Findings

- A. The Township of North Bergen ("Township") has determined that efficiencies in the Police Department can be further improved through the use of special law enforcement officers.
- B. <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:14-146.8, <u>et seq.</u>, the Special Law Enforcement Officers Act, authorizes a municipality, as it deems necessary, to appoint special law enforcement officers to perform the duties and responsibilities permitted by local ordinances and within the conditions and limitations established by law.

Section 2. Establishment of Class Two Special Law Enforcement Officer Position

There is hereby established the position of class two special law enforcement officer in the Township. Upon authorization of the Chief of Police, or his designee, officers of this class shall be authorized to exercise full powers and duties similar to those of a permanent, regularly appointed full-time police officer. The use of a firearm by an officer of this class may be authorized only after the officer has been fully certified as successfully completing training as prescribed by the Police Training Commission, established in the Department of Law and Public Safety pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:17B-70.

Section 3. Number of Class Two Positions Authorized

The number of class two special law enforcement officers shall not exceed 12.

Section 4. Eligibility & Qualifications

A. Determination of Eligibility. Before any special law enforcement officer is appointed, the Chief of Police shall ascertain the eligibility and

qualifications of the applicant and report these determinations, in writing, to the Board of Commissioners.

B. Qualifications.

- 1. No person may be appointed as a special law enforcement officer unless the person:
 - a) Is at least eighteen (18) years of age;
 - b) Is a resident of the State of New Jersey during the term of appointment;
 - c) Is able to read, write and speak the English language well and intelligently and has a high school diploma or its equivalent;
 - d) Is sound in body and of good health and is able to perform the physical functions of the duties assigned;
 - e) Is of good moral character;
 - f) Has not been convicted of any offense involving dishonesty or which would make him or her unfit to perform the duties of his or her office;
 - g) Has successfully undergone the same psychological testing that is required of all full-time police officers in the Township; and
 - h) Possesses a valid New Jersey drivers license.
- 2. Every applicant for the position of special law enforcement officer shall have fingerprints taken, which fingerprints shall be filed with the Division of State Police and the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

Section 5. Term of Appointment

Special law enforcement officers may be appointed for terms not to exceed one (1) year, and the appointments may be revoked by the Board of Commissioners for cause, after adequate hearing, unless the appointment is for four (4) months or less, in which event the appointment may be revoked without cause or hearing. Nothing herein shall be construed to require reappointment upon the expiration of the term. Special law enforcement officers so appointed

shall not be members of the police force of the Township, and their powers and duties shall cease at the expiration of the term for which appointed.

Section 6. Training Course and Certification Requirements

No person may commence his or her duties as a special law enforcement officer unless he or she has successfully completed the training course and certification requirements of N.J.S.A. 40A:14-146.11, unless such training requirements have been waived by the Police Training Commission.

Section 7. Uniforms, Equipment & Firearms

- A. Every special law enforcement officer, prior to the commencement of his or her duties, shall be furnished with a uniform which shall identify the officer's function. The uniform shall include, but not be limited to, a hat and appropriate badges which shall bear an identification number or name tag and the name of the Township. The uniform shall also include an insignia issued by the Police Training Commission which clearly indicates the officer's status as a special law enforcement officer and the type of certification issued by the Police Training Commission. All special law enforcement officers prior to the commencement of duties shall be in uniform properly displaying the appropriate insignia.
- B. Whenever a special law enforcement officer's appointment is revoked or a special law enforcement officer is not reappointed upon the expiration of the term, the special law enforcement officer shall return to their supervisor all Township issued uniforms, badges and equipment within fifteen (15) days of the revocation or expiration of the term.
- C. Special law enforcement officers shall carry and return firearms pursuant to the guidelines established in <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:146.14(b).

Section 8. Conduct of Special Law Enforcement Officers

- A. Special law enforcement officers shall comply with the rules and regulations applicable to the conduct and decorum of the permanent, regularly appointed police officers of the Township, as well as any rules and regulations applicable to the conduct and decorum of special law enforcement officers.
- B. Special law enforcement officers shall be under the supervision and direction of the Chief of Police and shall perform his or her duties only in the Township unless in fresh pursuit of any person pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2A:156-1, et seq.

- C. The Chief of Police, or his designee, may authorize special law enforcement officers, when on duty, to exercise the same powers and authority as permanent, regularly appointed police officers of the Township, including, but not limited to, the carrying of firearms and the power to arrest, subject to rules and regulations.
- D. Special law enforcement officers have no law enforcement authority while off-duty.

Section 9. Hours of Employment

The provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:14-146.16(a) and (c) regarding the maximum hours of employment of special law enforcement officers are hereby incorporated as if stated in full herein. Notwithstanding the foregoing, special law enforcement officers may only work a maximum of 24 hours per week, on a schedule to be determined by the commander of the Police Department Administrative Division.

Section 10. Limitation of Use of Officers

Special law enforcement officers may be employed only to assist the Township's law enforcement unit but may not be employed to replace or substitute for full-time regular police officers or in any way to diminish the number of full-time officers employed by the Township.

Section 11. Compensation

- A. The compensation for class two special law enforcement officers shall be not less than \$12.00 per hour, or more than \$25.00 per hour.
- B. Special law enforcement officers are not eligible for pensions, health benefits, paid sick leave, paid vacation or leave time, accrual of compensation time, or overtime pay.

Section 12. Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistency thereof.

Section 13. Severability

If any part or parts of this Ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 14. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication as required by law.

COMMERICAL VEHICLE PARKING ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN that:

Section 1: Definition

For purposes of this Ordinance, the term "commercial vehicle" shall mean a vehicle used for the transportation of persons for hire, compensation or profit, or designed or used for the transportation of property, materials, cargo, equipment or tools. The term commercial vehicle shall include, but not be limited to, commuter vans, food vending trucks, limousines, recreational vehicles, motor drawn vehicles, omnibuses, panel vans, pole trailers, road tractors, school buses, semi-trailers, taxicabs, tow trucks, trucks, and truck tractors, vehicles having more than 4 wheels, vehicles weighing more than 9,000 lbs., vehicles having a height in excess of 9.5 feet, vehicles having a length of more than 18 feet, vehicles having a width of more than 7 feet, vehicles having tool, cargo or equipment racks or cages in the interior or on the exterior of the vehicle, vehicles containing commercial or business lettering, advertising or graphics, and vehicles registered as commercial, omnibus, limousine, livery, taxi, farmer, commuter van, or school vehicle.

Section 2: Parking of Commercial Vehicles Prohibited In Residential Neighborhoods

Except as provided in Section 4 of this Ordinance, no person shall park or leave standing a commercial vehicle upon any front yard, side yard, rear yard, or any other private driveway or parking lot, where that vehicle is visible from the street in an R1, R2, R3, P1, or P2 residential zone.

Section 3: Parking of Commercial Vehicles In All Neighborhoods

Except as provided in Section 4 of this Ordinance, no person shall park or leave standing a commercial vehicle, upon any street, public land, avenue, road, or other public thoroughfare in the Township of North Bergen.

Section 4: Exceptions to Prohibition of Commercial Vehicles

- A. The prohibition as to commercial vehicles parking in areas provided for in Section 2 and Section 3 shall not apply to commercial vehicles that are in the process of rendering services to premises within said neighborhoods.
- B. A property that is the subject of a variance for business purposes or a pre-existing, non-conforming business use shall not be deemed to be in an R1, R2, R3, P1 or P2 residential zone.
- C. Rental moving trucks, utilized while under a rental agreement, shall be permitted to be parked for a continuous 72 hour time period.
- D. The prohibition as to commercial vehicles parking in areas provided for in Section 2 and Section 3 shall not apply to commercial vehicles, where the vehicle owner has obtained a valid residential parking permit from the North Bergen Parking Authority ("Parking Authority") pursuant to Section 5 of this Ordinance.
- E. Commercial vehicles, which have obtained a commercial parking permit from the Parking Authority, may park where parking is permitted on the following streets, or portions thereof:
 - 1. Both sides of Dell Avenue, south of 43rd Street;
 - 2. The west side of Dell Avenue, from 43rd Street to 49th Street;
 - 3. Both sides of Roustein Avenue;
 - 4. Both sides of Nolan Avenue;

- 5. The north side of 70th Street, west of Tonnelle Avenue; and
- 6. Both sides of 74th Street, west of Tonnelle Avenue.

Section 5: Obtaining a Residential Parking Permit

- A. The owner of a vehicle falling within the definition of commercial vehicle set forth in Section 1, may obtain a residential parking permit for a passenger van, panel van, or pickup truck, provided:
 - 1. the vehicle is not, and will not be, used for any business or commercial purpose, and the vehicle owner certifies to this fact;
 - 2. the vehicle does not contain any cargo or equipment racks or cages, either in the interior or on the exterior of the vehicle;
 - 3. the vehicle does not contain any commercial or business lettering, advertising or graphics;
 - 4. the vehicle is not registered as a commercial vehicle, omnibus, limousine, livery, taxi, farmer vehicle, commuter van, or school vehicle;
 - 5. the vehicle does not weigh more than 9,000 lbs; and
 - 6. with respect to a passenger van, the van does not contain more than three rows of seats, including the front seats.
 - B. In the event an applicant is denied a residential parking permit, the applicant may appeal the administrative decision of the Parking Authority to the Parking Authority Board of Commissioners. Said appeal shall be in writing and shall be considered solely on written submissions, unless the Parking Authority Board of Commissioners requests oral testimony or argument.
 - C. After having obtained a residential parking permit for a commercial vehicle pursuant to this Section, no person shall do any of

the following without first having returned their residential parking permit to the Parking Authority:

- Change, modify or alter their permitted vehicle so that it no longer would qualify for a residential parking permit under this Section;
 or
- 2. Use their permitted vehicle, or allow the use of their permitted vehicle, for the transportation of persons for hire, for compensation or profit, or for the transportation of property, materials, cargo, equipment or for any other commercial or business related purpose.
- D. The Parking Authority may revoke a residential parking permit issued for a commercial vehicle for any violation of Section 5.C. An administrative decision to revoke a residential parking permit may be appealed to the Parking Authority Board of Commissioners pursuant to the same procedures set forth in Section 5.B. Provided an appeal is filed within seven (7) business days of the revocation, the revocation will be considered stayed pending the conclusion of the appeal to the Parking Authority Board of Commissioners.
- E. The determination of whether a commercial vehicle qualifies for a residential parking permit, or whether a residential parking permit should be revoked, shall be within the exclusive discretion of the Parking Authority, based on the criteria set forth in this Section.

Section 6. Enforcement

The Parking Authority shall have and exercise the power and perform the duties associated with the management, operation and enforcement of this Ordinance. The North Bergen Police Department shall also enforce the provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 7: Penalties and Fines

- A. Owners of Commercial vehicles parked in violation of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$115.00, nor more than \$500.00 for each violation.
- B. Any person violating Section 5.C of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of \$500.00 for each violation.
- C. Any person who falsely represents himself, herself, or their vehicle as eligible for a residential parking permit, or who furnishes false information on an application for such a permit, shall be subject to a fine of \$500.00 for each violation.
- D. Any person holding a residential parking permit, issued pursuant to this Ordinance, who permits or allows the use or display of such parking permit on any motor vehicle, other than that for which the permit was issued, shall be subject to a fine of \$500.00 for each violation.
- E. Any person who copies, reproduces or otherwise brings into existence, a facsimile or counterfeit residential parking permit, or allows another person to copy, reproduce or otherwise bring into existence a facsimile or counterfeit residential parking permit shall be subject to a fine of \$500.00 for each such violation.

Section 8: Severability

If any part or parts of this Ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 9: Consistency

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistency thereof.

Section 10: Repealer

This Ordinance supersedes, replaces and repeals Ordinance No. 302-16, except to the extent any summonses or complaints were issued under Ordinance No. 215-14 prior to the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 11: Effective Date:

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.
