



WHEREAS, the Township of North Bergen's ("Township's") policy is to treat employees and prospective employees in a manner consistent with all applicable employment laws and regulations, including, but not limited to, Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended by the Equal Opportunity Act of 1972, the Age Discrimination in Employment Act, the Equal Pay for Equal Work Act, the Fair Labor Standards Act, the New Jersey Law Against Discrimination, the Americans with Disabilities Act, the Family and Medical Leave Act, the Conscientious Employee Protection Act, the Public Employee Occupational Safety and Health Act, the New Jersey Civil Service Act, the New Jersey Attorney General's guidelines with respect to Police Department personnel matters, the New Jersey Workers Compensation Act, the Federal Consolidated Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act (COBRA), and the Open Public Meeting Act; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Commissioners has determined that there is a need for personnel policies and procedures to ensure that employees and prospective employees are treated in a manner consistent with these laws and regulations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this manual is intended to provide guidelines covering public service by Township employees and is not an employment contract, and the provisions of the manual may be amended and supplemented from time to time without notice and at the sole discretion of the Township.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that to the maximum extent permitted by law, employment practices for the Township shall operate under the legal doctrine known as "employment at will."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Township Administrator and all managerial/supervisory personnel are responsible for these employment practices, and the Township Administrator's Administrative Clerk, and General Counsel shall assist the Township Administrator in the implementation of the policies and procedures in the Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual.



Farag of 1323 – 14th Street, 2nd Floor, Antonio S. Lopez of 411 – 71st Street, Apt. # 2, Grace L. Ortiz of 7015 Durham Avenue, 2nd Floor and Janet C. Reynolds of 7709 Durham Avenue, North Bergen, N.J. 07047.

Section 2: The aforesaid space shall be used only by a motor vehicle displaying a permit issued by the North Bergen Police Department identifying the location of said handicapped parking space and the specific motor vehicle entitled to use same.

Section 3: The North Bergen Department of Public Works shall establish a restricted parking zone at the above location and shall erect a sign with the legend "Handicapped Parking for Resident Vehicle License Plate Number "2 3 5 5 H B" for Dulce Beriguette, "H Y 9 4 1 9" for Betty Bravo, "H V 8 0 8 7" for Amal A.
