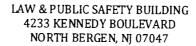

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 710-49 REGULATING TRAFFIC CONDITIONS EXISTING IN THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN DO ORDAIN:

Section 1: Background

- A. The Township of North Bergen ("Township") has previously amended Ordinance No. 710-49, which regulates traffic conditions within the Township, to restrict trucks of certain weights from traveling on certain streets in the Township. See Ordinance Nos. 127-86, 201-87, 367-90, 373-90 and 869-01.
- B. Due to the steep incline in the area east of Tonnelle Avenue, trucks attempting to travel to the east of Tonnelle Avenue on 73rd and 74th Streets often attempt to turn at Liberty Avenue, causing disruptions and damages to surrounding property in the area. As a result, the Township wishes to limit truck traffic in the area as set forth herein.

Section 2: Amendment

Section 11 of Ordinance No. 710-49, as amended, is further amended as follows to add the following streets:

Trucks of over four tons gross weight are hereby excluded from the following streets or parts of streets, except for the pick-up or delivery of materials on such streets:

73rd Street, from Tonnelle Avenue to Liberty Avenue

74th Street, from Liberty Avenue to Tonnelle Avenue

Section 3: Repealer All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistency thereof.

Section 4: Severability: If any part or parts of this Ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 5: Effective Date: This Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication as required by law and approval, if required by law, by the Commissioner of Transportation of the State of New Jersey or by such other authorities as may be required by law.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSING OF STREETS FOR BLOCK PARTIES AND ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS THEREFOR

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen, County of Hudson and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. Definitions.

As used in this Ordinance, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

BLOCK PARTY

A neighborhood gathering, or organized party, of persons who reside on the portion of a residential street sought to be closed for said gathering or party.

PERMITTEE

Includes the block party contact person, the applicant of the permit, the persons indicated within § 3C(6) and participants.

TOWNSHIP

The Township of North Bergen.

SECTION 2. Permit Required.

No person or organization shall use any public street, sidewalk or public right-of-way for a block party in the Township without a permit. Nothing hereby shall be deemed to apply to the closing of any street for public safety reasons by the Township or any other governmental agency having jurisdiction over the public streets, or to any event conducted or sponsored by the Township. The closing of streets for parades, processions or similar vehicular and/or pedestrian events shall not be governed by this Ordinance but shall be governed by Ordinance # 173-13, or any successor ordinance or amendment thereto.

SECTION 3. Application To Conduct Block Party.

- A. A person seeking issuance of a block party permit shall file an application with the Township Clerk, together with an application fee of \$20 on forms provided by the Township Clerk.
- B. An application for a block party permit shall be filed with the Township Clerk not less than 30 days before the date on which it is proposed to conduct the block party.
- C. The application for a block party permit shall set forth the following information:

- (1) The name, address and telephone numbers (home phone number, work phone number and another supplemental number, such as a cell phone number) of the person requesting the block party permit. The person requesting the permit shall be deemed the contact person unless otherwise specified to the Township Clerk.
- (2) The name and address of any organization the applicant is representing, if any.
- (3) The proposed date and time of the block party, including the times at which such block party will commence and terminate, said commencement being no earlier than 10:00 a.m. and such termination being no later than 9:00 p.m.
- (4) The Township street where the block party is proposed, along with any cross streets.
- (5) The names, addresses, telephone numbers, blocks and lots of the property owners and tenants thereof for each impacted property on the street or portion of the street where the block party is proposed.
- (6) Signatures of 95% of those property owners and residents indicated in Subsection <u>C(5)</u> of this section, said signatures indicating consent to the proposed block party, consent to the proposed street closure, and acknowledgment that all residents and their invitees shall adhere to all applicable laws, regulations and ordinances, including, but not limited to, noise ordinances, fireworks regulations, and ordinances prohibiting public consumption of alcoholic beverages.
- (7) The activities planned for said block party, the estimated number of persons participating and/or attending, and any large items, including but not limited to, dunk tanks, inflatable jumps, stages, and vehicles/trailers which will be parked or placed in the street.
- (8) Whether any music will be provided at the block party, either live or recorded.
- (9) The number, types and locations of all loudspeakers and amplifying devices to be used.
- (10) The proposed location and description of any temporary structures, rides or other items to be placed in the roadway.
- D. Upon submission of an application for a block party and acceptance of the appropriate fee, the Township Clerk shall request a certified list of property owners from the tax assessor for the area of the proposed block party. Said list shall be kept on file with the application. The Township Clerk shall review the application for completeness and forward said application to the Chief of Police, the Superintendent of the Department of Public Works and the Township Administrator for review in accordance with § 4.

SECTION 4. Standards For Issuance Of Block Party Permits.

- A. Approval of the Chief of Police and Superintendent of the Department of Public Works.
 - (1) The Township Clerk shall notify the Chief of Police and Superintendent of the Department of Public Works of the block party application and request that the area of the proposed block party be inspected using the following criteria:
 - (a) The conduct and location of the block party will not substantially interrupt or impede the safe and orderly movement of traffic.
 - (b) The conduct of the block party will not be likely to result in damage to persons or property nor cause serious harm to the public.
 - (c) The conduct of the block party will not interfere with the movement of public safety vehicles and equipment (e.g. emergency medical services, police, or fire protection) to such an extent that adequate emergency services cannot be provided by the Township.
 - (d) Such other concerns deemed necessary in order to properly provide for traffic control, street and property maintenance and the protection of the public health, safety and welfare.
 - (2) If the Chief of Police and Superintendent of the Department of Public Works, in consultation with the North Hudson Regional Fire and Rescue, determines that the criteria of this section are satisfied, he or she shall sign the application, indicating whether said application is recommended for approval and any special conditions required.
- B. Closing of streets.
 - (1) The Township Clerk shall forward a block party application to the Township Administrator for a determination as to the closing of streets. A block party permit shall be subject to the provisions and procedures provided herein for the closing of municipal streets. Any permit issuance shall be contingent upon the Township Administrator providing for the closing of the street or streets which are the subject of the block party application, to be determined in accordance with this section.
 - (2) Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:67-16.9 and for the purpose of carrying out the preceding sections of this Ordinance, the Board of Commissioners authorizes the Township Administrator to provide for the closing of any Township street, or portion thereof, to motor vehicle traffic on any day or days, or during specified hours on any day or days, whenever he/she finds that such closing is necessary for the preservation of the public safety, health or welfare, in accordance with the requirements provided for herein.

- (3) A permit for the temporary closing of a street shall not be issued unless all of the following conditions are met:
 - (a) The Township street proposed to be closed is a residential street.
 - (b) The portion of the street proposed to be closed is no more than one block in length.
 - (c) The speed limit on the portion of the street proposed to be closed is 25 mph or less.
 - (d) The street has no more than two lanes.
 - (e) The street does not have an active bus stop nor is it located on a regularly scheduled bus route.
 - (f) Block parties shall be authorized only upon streets under the jurisdiction of the Township, and shall not be authorized upon any street which is under the jurisdiction of Hudson County, the State of New Jersey or any public entity other than the Township.
 - (g) The closing of the street does not interfere with school services or school bus routes (on school days or during hours when school is in session)

SECTION 5. Requirements For The Issuance Of A Permit.

- A. Insurance and indemnity.
 - (1) All applicants must provide a certificate of insurance specifically naming the Township of North Bergen as an additional insured providing general liability, bodily injury and property damage coverage with minimum limits of liability not less than \$1,000,000
 - (2) The applicant shall agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Township, its agents, servants, representatives and employees, from and against all losses, damages, claims, liabilities and causes of action of every kind, or character and nature, as well as costs and fees, including reasonable attorneys' fees connected therewith, and the expense of investigation thereof, based upon or arising out of damages or injuries to third persons or their property caused by the acts, omissions or negligence of the applicant, anyone for whose acts the applicant may be liable, or any claims arising out of or in any manner relating to the activities permitted pursuant to this Ordinance to the extent permitted by law. The applicant shall give the Township prompt and reasonable notice of any such claims or actions.
- B. No block party permit shall be issued if, within the same calendar year of the date of the proposed block party, a block party permit has been issued for the same street or portion of the street which is the subject of the currently proposed block party.
- C. No block party permit shall be issued to any person or entity if a block party permit has previously been issued to such person or entity and said

- previously issued permit was revoked by the Township due to violations of this Ordinance or of any applicable ordinances, laws or regulations.
- D. The temporary closing of a street for a block party shall not be authorized earlier than 10:00 a.m. on the date of the event and not later than 9:00 p.m. on said date and shall not be of a duration longer than 6 continuous hours. The street must be reopened by 9:00 p.m. or the end of such 6 hour period, whichever first occurs, on the date of the event free of any debris, refuse or other material interfering with the safe and free passage of pedestrians and vehicles.
- E. Proper warning signs of such closing of any street, or portion thereof, must be posted during the time same is closed.
- F. No person shall operate a motor vehicle upon any street or portion thereof during the time such street or portion thereof is closed pursuant to this Ordinance except for vehicles used in connection with the block party, municipal vehicles, and emergency vehicles.
- G. A street or portion thereof blocked off for a party shall not be obstructed by obstacles which cannot be readily moved to allow emergency and hazard vehicles to enter it in response to an emergency.

SECTION 5. Issuance Of Permit; Conditions.

If all the requirements of this Ordinance for the issuance of a block party permit have been met satisfactorily, the Township Clerk shall issue a permit for a block party, subject to any conditions determined by the Township Administrator to be reasonably calculated to reduce or minimize dangers and hazards to vehicular or pedestrian traffic and the public health, safety and welfare, including, but not limited to, changes in time, duration or number of participants. Upon issuance of a block party permit, the Township Clerk shall forward a copy of said permit to the Township Administrator, the Chief of Police, and the Superintendent of the Department of Public Works.

SECTION 6. Duties Of Permittee.

In addition to any duties of the permittee(s) which are a condition of the block party permit as issued and any other obligations of the permittee(s) delineated otherwise in this Ordinance, all permittees shall:

- A. Comply with all applicable laws and ordinances.
- B. Be responsible for cleanup of any items, trash and garbage from the street which is the subject of the permit.
- C. Require that the block party contact person or other person heading or leading such activity shall carry the block party permit upon his or her person during the conduct of the block party.
- D. Assure that any vendors utilized during the block party are properly licensed as required under any other ordinance or law.
- E. If permission to close the street shall be granted, the person or persons, association, firm, or corporation requesting such closing shall conduct the

operation so that there shall be minimum inconvenience to the general public and in such a manner that, upon the expiration of the permitted street closing period, such street is reopened, free of any debris, refuse, or other material interfering with the safe and free passage of pedestrians and vehicles.

F. Traffic barricades shall be provided and put in place by the Department of Public Works during the period of closure and thereafter removed and retrieved by the Department of Public Works.

SECTION 7. Revocation Of Permit.

The Township shall have the authority to revoke a block party permit issued hereunder upon the violation of any of the standards for issuance as set forth in this Ordinance or in the event of circumstances endangering public health, safety and welfare.

SECTION 8. Violations And Penalties.

Any person who violates any provision of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000, by imprisonment for a term not to exceed 30 days and/or by a term of community service not to exceed 30 days. A separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

SECTION 9. Inconsistency.

All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 10. Severability.

If any sentence, section, clause or other portion of this Ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance, shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid for any reason, such judgment shall not affect, impair or repeal the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION 11. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as required
