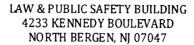

Armas of 1703 - 48th Street, Hector Cespedes of 614 -87th Street, Apt. # 19, Usha T. Desai of 1012 Grand Avenue, Maria E. Dominguez of 1301 - 27th Street, 2nd Floor and Girish B. Shah of 625 Kennedy Boulevard, Apt. # 2, North Bergen, N.J. 07047.

Section 2: The aforesaid space shall be used only by a motor vehicle displaying a permit issued by the North Bergen Police Department identifying the location of said handicapped parking space and the specific motor vehicle entitled to use same.

Section 3: The North Bergen Department of Public Works shall establish a restricted parking zone at the above location and shall erect a sign with the legend "Handicapped Parking for Resident Vehicle License Plate Number "A R M A S 1" for Brenda S. Armas, "H W 3 0 9 2" for Hector Cespedes, "C 9 0 F D K" for Usha T. Desai, and "X 9 3 G R T" for Maria E. Dominguez, "Y W M 6 0 D" for Girish B. Shah and this Ordinance Number.

Section 4: This ordinance shall remain in effect for two (2) years ending December 31st of the second year from its effective date at which point it will expire and be of no further force or effect unless it is renewed for a further two (2) year period by formal resolution of the Board of Commissioners in accordance with Ordinance Nos. 1115-07 and 40-10.

Section 5: Any person who commits a violation of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of at least \$300.00 and up to 90 days of Community Service on such terms and in such form as the Municipal Court Judge deems appropriate or any combination thereof. WHEREAS, 45th Street is a public street in the Township of North Bergen, County of Hudson, State of New Jersey, shown on the Official Map of the Township of North Bergen; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid portion of 45th Street between Bergen Turnpike and Tonnelle Avenue appears on the Tax Map as being 50.28 feet in width at the west end and 54.82 feet in width at the east end and is presently improved; and

WHEREAS, AL 1 Properties, Inc., the owner of the property adjacent to this portion of 45th Street, has requested the portion of 45th Street between Bergen Turnpike and Tonnelle Avenue, as more particularly described on Exhibit "A" attached; and

WHEREAS, the Township's Engineer, Boswell McClave Engineering, has reviewed the request and have indicated that the street vacation would be appropriate; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen, after due investigation and consideration have determined that this portion of 45th Street is improved and not necessary for public use and the public interest to be served is such as to warrant the vacation of that portion of 45th Street as described in this ordinance, and the vacation would benefit the health, welfare and public safety of

the citizens of the Township of North Bergen.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN that:

Section 1. All that portion of 45th Street described on Exhibit "A" is hereby vacated and the public rights in and to such public street are hereby released and extinguished.

The portion of 45th Street to be vacated being more particularly described on Schedule "A", attached hereto.

Section 2. The Official Map of the Township of North Bergen is hereby amended to indicate that portion of 45th Street as vacated as particularly described above.

Section 3. The portion of 45th Street which is set forth on the metes and bounds description above within the Township of North Bergen, is hereby vacated as a public reservation, and the rights of the public therein are hereby released and extinguished, except all rights and privileges then possessed by Public Utilities, as defined in N.J.S.A. 48:2-13, and by any cable television company, as defined in the "Cable Television Act", P.L. 1972, C. 186 (N.J.S.A. 48:5A-1 et seq.), and the Township of North Bergen, the North Bergen Municipal Utilities Authority, the County of Hudson and the State of New Jersey DOT and their successors, to maintain, repair, and replace existing facilities in, adjacent to, over or under the portion of 45th Street to be vacated.

Section 4. At no time shall a permanent structure be constructed on the

vacated portion of 45th Street.

Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this

ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistency thereof.

Section 6. If any article, section, sub-section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason deemed to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not effect the remaining portion of this ordinance.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall take effect upon the publication as required by law.

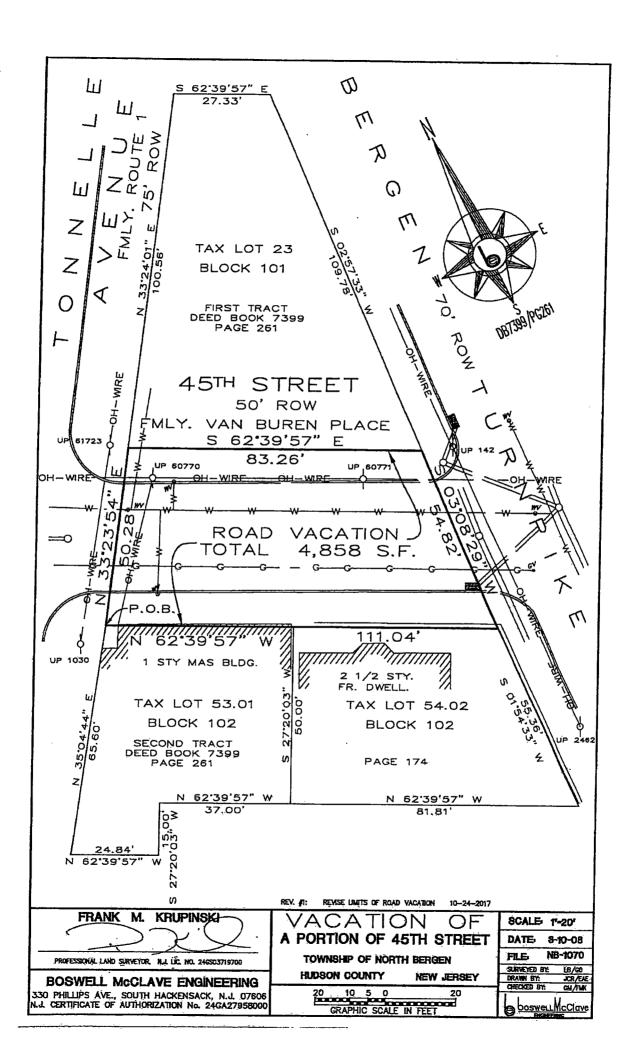
