WHEREAS, each year, more than 6 million lives are lost to stroke worldwide; and

WHEREAS, stroke is a leading cause of serious long-term disability and the fifth-leading cause of death in the United States, killing about 130,000 people nationwide and 3,400 citizens of New Jersey each year; and

WHEREAS, between 2012 and 2030 total direct annual stroke-related medical costs are expected to increase from \$71.55 billion to \$184.13 billion; and overall, total annual costs of stroke are projected to increase to \$240.67 billion by 2030, an increase of 129 percent; and

WHEREAS, new and effective treatments have been developed to treat and minimize the severity and damaging effect of strokes, although more research is needed; and

WHEREAS, much can be done to prevent, treat and rehabilitate those who suffer from strokes; and

WHEREAS, one in three Americans can't recall any stroke warning signs or symptoms; and

WHEREAS, the American Stroke Association's *Together* to End Stroke campaign helps people learn how to recognize and respond to stroke warning signs using the acronym FAST, where F stands for Face Drooping, A stands for Arm Weakness, S stands for Speech Difficulty, and T means Time to call 9-1-1 if any signs are present; and

WHEREAS, on World Stroke Day, October 29th, the American Stroke Association will encourage Americans to work together to end stroke by learning the acronym F.A.S.T. and understanding the importance of calling 911 at the first sign of stroke without delay; and

WHEREAS, the American Stroke Association, in collaboration with stroke organizations throughout the world, will encourage the public to face the facts about stroke; and

WHEREAS, lives worldwide can improve with better awareness, access and action around stroke.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mayor Nicholas J. Sacco, Mayor of the Township of North Bergen, County of Hudson, State of New Jersey, do hereby proclaim October 29th do hereby proclaim October 29th to be "WORLD STROKE DAY" and urge all the citizens of our state to familiarize themselves with the risk factors associated with stroke, recognize the warning signs and symptoms, and on first signs of a stroke dial 911 immediately so that we might continue to reduce the devastating effects of stroke on our population.

RESOLUTION CALLING UPON THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NEW YORK AND NEW JERSEY TO WIDEN THE GEORGE WASHINGTON BRIDGE'S SIDEWALKS

WHEREAS, the George Washington Bridge's sidewalks are the only connection across the Hudson River between New York City and New Jersey for pedestrians, runners, and bicyclists; and

WHEREAS, the paths are heavily used, with an average of 1,700 cyclists and 900 pedestrians crossing each day; and

WHEREAS, the sidewalks are ten feet wide except where the bridge's suspender ropes pass through, where they are less than seven feet wide; and

WHEREAS, according to Federal Highway Administration guidelines, sharedused paths should be at least ten feet wide and up to fourteen feet wide if they are heavily used; and

WHEREAS, the Port of Authority of New York and New Jersey is planning an extensive renovation that will replace all of the bridge's suspender ropes beginning in 2017, and lasting until 2024; and

WHEREAS, as part of the project, the sidewalks will be replaced and new ramps that will provide access to the sidewalks will be constructed, but the sidewalks will not be widened; and

WHEREAS, the Township of North Bergen ("Township") has made efforts in recent years to make its roadways safer and more convenient for pedestrians and bicyclists, and has recently approved a bike-share program in the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Port Authority's own Bicycle Policy states that its goals are to integrate "improved bicycle access" and "safe bicycle lanes," and to "promote the safe co-existence of motor vehicles, bicycles and pedestrians" at its facilities; and

WHEREAS, the width of the bridge's sidewalks do not met federal standards for high-use pedestrian and bicycle paths, and

WHEREAS, the planned renovation project presents a unique opportunity to build sidewalks that would be able to safely and comfortably accommodate the increasing number of pedestrians and bicyclists expected to use the bridge in the decades to come.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen recognize that handicapped drivers face unique difficulties in the location of parking spaces; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen have been empowered by N.J.S.A. 39:4-205 to restrict certain areas for handicapped parking; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 503-93, Ordinance No. 1115-07, Ordinance No. 40-10 and Ordinance No. 203-13 establish the terms and conditions for handicapped spaces.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen that:

Section 1: One restricted handicapped parking space be and hereby is established in front of the residence of Walter De La Cruz of 1208 - 9th Street, 1st Floor, Amanda M. Rodriguez - Castillo of 6124 Durham Avenue, Apt. # 1 and Pedro L. Suarez of 1121 -22nd Street, North Bergen, N.J. 07047.

Section 2: The aforesaid space shall be used only by a motor vehicle displaying a permit issued by the North Bergen Police Department identifying the location of said handicapped parking space and the specific motor vehicle entitled to use same.

Section 3: The North Bergen Department of Public Works shall establish a restricted parking zone at the above location and shall erect a sign with the legend "Handicapped Parking for Resident Vehicle License Plate Number "H Z 4 4 2 1" for Walter De La Cruz, "L 2 5 G K K" for Amanda M. Rodriguez - Castillo and "H Y 6 7 5 1" for Pedro L. Suarez, and this Ordinance Number.

Section 4: This ordinance shall remain in effect for two (2) years ending December 31st of the second year from its effective date at which point it will expire and be of no further force or effect unless it is renewed for a further two (2) year period by formal resolution of the Board of Commissioners in accordance with Ordinance Nos. 1115-07 and 40-10.

Section 5: Any person who commits a violation of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of at least \$300.00 and up to 90 days of Community Service on such terms and in such form as the Municipal Court Judge deems appropriate or any combination thereof. A separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which the violation continues.

Section 6: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistency thereof.

Section 7: If any part or parts of this ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 8: This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication as required by law.
