	Yes	Many municipalities have created one or more authorities (including fire districts, utilities authorities, redevelopment authorities, housing authorities, port authorities, etc.) to provide greater focus and attention on addressing a public need, or to reduce governing body burdens. While creation of an authority is often appropriate, and many authorities successfully fulfill their missions, authorities with weak membership or insufficient local-level monitoring can become wasteful, inefficient and unresponsive to the public they serve. WHEREAS, Across the nation, traffic crashes caused 35,092 fatalities in 2015, and are the leading cause of death for young people ages 15 to 34; and,

WHEREAS, In New Jersey, 603 individuals lost their lives in traffic crashes in 2016; and,

WHEREAS, Pedestrian-related crashes accounted for 27.5 percent of the State's traffic fatalities, while 19 percent of all fatal crashes involved traveling at unsafe speeds; and,

WHEREAS, Motorcyclists, bicycle riders and pedestrians face increased risks on New Jersey's roadways, as people opt for alternative modes of transportation; and,

WHEREAS, 66 motorcyclists, 18 bicyclists and 166 pedestrians were killed in New Jersey in traffic-related fatalities in 2016; and,

WHEREAS, Safer driving behaviors such as buckling up, every ride; obeying posted speed limits; stopping for pedestrians in crosswalks and using crosswalks when walking; avoiding aggressive driving behaviors; never driving impaired; wearing proper safety gear when riding a motorcycle or bicycle; and focusing solely on driving by avoiding distractions, can dramatically reduce the number of traffic-related injuries and deaths.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, NICHOLAS J. SACCO, MAYOR OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN, COUNTY OF HUDSON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, do hereby proclaim October 10, 2017, "Put the Brakes on Fatalities Day®", and call upon everyone to put these lifesaving behaviors into practice to improve safety on the roadways in our community and throughout the State.





The Township Building Department is hereby authorized to waive the road opening security deposit requirement for each road opening Verizon requests, and to accept a single \$50,000 bond agreement in lieu thereof, the form of which shall be approved by the Township Attorney. Unless sooner revoked, the authorization to waive the security deposit requirement for each Verizon road opening shall expire on June 30, 2018.
- 3. The waiver provided for herein may be revoked by the Township Administrator at any time, with or without cause.
- 4. The Mayor, Township Administrator, Chief Financial Officer, Township Attorney, Township Clerk, Township Purchasing Agent, Township Engineer, Director of Community Improvements, and any other necessary official, officer or employee of the Township be and they are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents and to take any and all actions necessary to complete and realize the intent and purpose of this Resolution.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen recognize that handicapped drivers face unique difficulties in the location of parking spaces; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen have been

empowered by N.J.S.A. 39:4-205 to restrict certain areas for handicapped parking; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 503-93, Ordinance No. 1115-07, Ordinance No. 40-10 and Ordinance No. 203-13 establish the terms and conditions for handicapped spaces.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen that:

Section 1: One restricted handicapped parking space be and hereby is established in front of the residence of Walter De La Cruz of 1208 - 9th Street, 1st Floor, Amanda M. Rodriguez - Castillo of 6124 Durham Avenue, Apt. # 1 and Pedro L. Suarez of 1121 -22nd Street, North Bergen, N.J. 07047.

Section 2: The aforesaid space shall be used only by a motor vehicle displaying a permit issued by the North Bergen Police Department identifying the location of said handicapped parking space and the specific motor vehicle entitled to use same.

Section 3: The North Bergen Department of Public Works shall establish a restricted parking zone at the above location and shall erect a sign with the legend "Handicapped Parking for Resident Vehicle License Plate Number "H Z 4 4 2 1" for Walter De La Cruz, "L 2 5 G K K" for Amanda M. Rodriguez - Castillo and "H Y 6 7 5 1" for Pedro L. Suarez, and this Ordinance Number.

Section 4: This ordinance shall remain in effect for two (2) years ending December 31st of the second year from its effective date at which point it will expire and be of no further force or effect unless it is renewed for a further two (2) year period by formal resolution of the Board of Commissioners in accordance with Ordinance Nos. 1115-07 and 40-10.

Section 5: Any person who commits a violation of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of at least \$300.00 and up to 90 days of Community Service on such terms and in such form as the Municipal Court Judge deems appropriate or any combination thereof. A separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which the violation continues.

Section 6: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistency thereof.

Section 7: If any part or parts of this ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 8: This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication as required by law.
